Dear Mr. Cox,

I received your letter of March 24, 2018 notifying me of your demand that Addison either divert our existing sewer flows from a Farmers Branch sewer line or install a "TRA Deduct" meter by May 25, 2018. Your decision to terminate this long-standing arrangement is unfortunate. Even more regrettable is the reason driving this decision: the Farmers Branch Creek dispute.

As you know we have been reviewing options internally to resolve this issue for the past several months. While we have a better understanding of our options and are moving forward to select one that is in the best long-term interests of both of our communities, your May 25, 2018 deadline may prove impossible to meet. As such, we will review and consider all remedies available to us to protect the public health of our residents and businesses.
