(b): In each odd-numbered year three (3) council members and a Mayor shall be elected and in each even-numbered year three (3) council members shall be elected; (c) The Mayor and other members of the Council shall be elected from the Town at large, for a term of two (2) years; and (h) No person shall serve as Mayor for more than three (3) successive terms of office, and no person shall serve as a council member for more than three (3) successive terms of office.

Candidate Eligibility Requirements Deadline to Be 18 years of age or older on the day of the election

- 2. Be a citizen of the United States.
- 3. Not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be:
 (a) totally mentally incapacitated; or (b) partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.
- 4. Not have been finally convicted of a felony or, if so convicted, must have: (a) fully discharged the sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, or supervision, or completed a period of probation ordered by any court; or (b) been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to vote.
- 5. Be a Resident of the city for at least 12 months.
- 6. Be a registered voter on the day of the election.
- 7. Candidates must be nominated by petition or may place their own name in nomination per City Charter: [link]
- 8. Application and Petition must be filed together by the filing deadline
- Candidate Packets, including the application and petition are available in the City Secretary's Office the first week of January each year.

Candidates are strongly encouraged to obtain a candidate

February 12, 2021 by 5:00 pm

The filing period begins on the 108th day prior to the election date and ends on the 78th day at 5 p.m. prior to the election date.
