<p><i>Pursuant to Home Rule Charter Section 8.04 "Number, selection, and term of Council"</i> (b): In each odd-numbered year three (3) council members and a Mayor shall be elected and in each even-numbered year three (3) council members shall be elected; (c) The Mayor and other members of the Council shall be elected from the Town at large, for a term of two (2) years; and (h) No person shall serve as Mayor for more than three (3) successive terms of office, and no person shall serve as a council member for more than three (3) successive terms of office.</p>

Candidate Eligibility Requirements	Deadline to File Candidate Application	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be 18 years of age or older on the day of the election 2. Be a citizen of the United States. 3. Not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be: (a) totally mentally incapacitated; or (b) partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote. 4. Not have been finally convicted of a felony or, if so convicted, must have: (a) fully discharged the sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, or supervision, or completed a period of probation ordered by any court; or (b) been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to vote. 5. Be a Resident of the city for at least 12 months. 6. Be a registered voter on the day of the election. 7. Candidates must be nominated by petition or may place their own name in nomination per City Charter: [link] 8. Application and Petition must be filed together by the filing deadline 9. Candidate Packets, including the application and petition are available in the City Secretary's Office the first week of January each year. <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Candidates are strongly encouraged to obtain a candidate</i></p>	<p>February 12, 2021 by 5:00 pm</p> <p><i>The filing period begins on the 108th day prior to the election date and ends on the 78th day at 5 p.m. prior to the election date.</i></p>
