(b): In each odd-numbered year three (3) council members and a Mayor shall be elected and in each even-numbered year three (3) council members shall be elected; (c) The Mayor and other members of the Council shall be elected from the Town at large, for a term of two (2) years; and (h) No person shall serve as Mayor for more than three (3) successive terms of office, and no person shall serve as a council member for more than three (3) successive terms of office.

## CCANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & DEADLINE TO FILE **Candidate Eligibility Requirements Deadline to File Candidate Application** 1. Be 18 years of age or older on the day of the election. 2. Be a citizen of the United States. 3. Not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be: (a) totally mentally incapacitated; or (b) partially mentally incapacitated without the February 11, 2022 by 5:00 pm right to vote. 4. Not have been finally convicted of a felony or, if so convicted, must have: (a) fully discharged the sentence, including any term of The filing period begins on the 108th day prior to incarceration, parole, or supervision, or the election date and ends on the $78^{th}$ day at 5 p.m. completed a period of probation ordered by prior to the election date. any court; or (b) been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to vote. 5. Be a Resident of the city for at least 12 months. 6. Be a registered voter on the day of the
