Metrocrest Services Seeks Volunteers to Help with Homeless Count



Each year in January, a count of the homeless population called the Point In Time (PIT) Homeless Count is conducted throughout the U.S. The count helps determine what federal funds are allocated to each county. While Dallas County and Denton County have participated in the count for many years, they have never included the portion of those counties in the Metrocrest area (Carrollton, Farmers Branch, Addison, and Coppell). Over the past few years, Metrocrest Services has seen a growing number of homeless, both individuals and families, in our community.

On January 24, 2019, from 7pm - 11pm,

Metrocrest Services will coordinate the PIT Count for our community and they need your help (ages 18 and older). They anticipate to need approximately 100 volunteers to work in teams of 3-5 to count homeless individuals. Each team would be assigned a local police officer and training will be provided in advance.
