
Have you Registered Your Alarm System?

Beginning January 1, all residents and businesses who use their alarm system (even if it is not monitored), must register it at AddisonAlarmRegistration.com. There is no annual fee for residents (\$50 for businesses) and you will receive three free false alarm calls. However, if you do not register your system, you will be charged \$100 for the first false alarm. That fee will be waived if you register your system within 30 days.
