#### Addison Theatre Centre's Main Stage to be Named "Terry Martin Main Stage"



At the [September 27 meeting](#), the City Council approved the WaterTower Theatre's request to name the Addison Theatre Centre's Main Stage, the "Terry Martin Main Stage." Addison's Naming Rights Policy requires the WaterTower Theatre to seek Council approval for exclusive naming right for areas within the Theatre.

The naming of WaterTower Theatre's main performance space was made possible by a donation from long-time supporter Stan Graner who wanted to honor Terry Martin's 17 years of commitment to WaterTower Theatre. During Martin's time at WaterTower Theatre as its Producing Artistic Director, he produced over 150 plays and directed 60 of those productions himself.

The WaterTower Theatre plans to present the [dedication of "The Terry Martin Main Stage"](#) at the opening of *A Doll's House* on Monday, October 15.
