### **Council Discusses Code Compliance Issues and Strategies for Hotels**

Over the past two years, the City Council has held numerous meetings to discuss strategies for addressing hotels that are not meeting the community's expectations. In June 2017, Council requested that staff investigate Budget Suites of America, located at 15130 Marsh Lane, to determine whether the property is in violation of its zoning because the company provides lodging for longer periods of time than are typical of hotels. WaterTower Theatre's Artistic Director Joni Schultz gave City Council a brief overview of the Theatre's current season and a sneak preview of the upcoming season at the June 26 City Council Meeting. She shared that WaterTower had great success with its diverse productions this year, attracting 20,000 patrons, including 1,000 new ticket buyers. The productions were also popular with the media, garnering more than 100 media mentions. The Theatre launched a community engagement program this year called, "Intersections." Through Intersections, WaterTower not only engages the community in new ways, but it also develops partnerships with other nonprofit organizations across the Metroplex.

The theme for next season is "Come Together." WaterTower will be featuring plays where clashes happen and the characters are searching for ways to come together - and sometimes succeeding. Ms. Schultz shared that the Theatre's vision to connect Addison to the world and the world to Addison through the creation of innovative live theatre has already begun and there is much more that they plan to do.

# **Super 8 Motel Update**

The Town has been in regular contact with the property owner of the Super 8 Motel on Beltway Drive since a fire severely damaged the motel on March 22, 2018. The property owner is waiting to hear from their insurance company on the insurance settlement before taking any action on the property. The Town has to provide the property owner a reasonable amount of time to take action related to the property but has been checking regularly to ensure the property is clean and secured.

It is unknown at this time whether the current property owner plans on keeping the property for redevelopment or if they plan to sell. The property, as it is currently zoned, allows hotels by right (without

a Special Use Permit) as long as it conforms with the Town's current definition of a hotel, which requires that the rooms be accessed only through an interior corridor and that they provide a lobby, meeting space, fitness center, and a commercial kitchen. If the damage to the Super 8 motel is not greater than 50%, the building can be rebuilt exactly as it was. If the damage is greater than 50%, it could still be rebuilt as a hotel, but it would have to comply with the Town's current requirements related to current building and fire codes, landscaping, and sidewalks, and the current definition of a hotel.

We will provide additional updates when new information becomes available.
