Council Updates

Council Reconsiders Election Day Polling Location Change

On election day, Addison residents have always voted at either Fire Station 1 or Fire Station 2, depending on which precinct they live in. At the January 8 Council Meeting, the City Council approved an ordinance moving the voting location for the May 4 general election from Fire Station 2 to the Addison Athletic Club. Council reversed that decision at their February 7 meeting. The south side polling location on May 4 will continue to be located at Addison Fire Station 2 on Beltway Drive.

Upcoming Public Hearings

The following public hearing will take place at the Planning and Zoning Commission (P&Z) Meeting on Tuesday, February 19 at Addison Town Hall. The [P&Z agenda](#) will be posted on the Town's website three days prior to the meeting.

Case 1791-Z/Vitruvian Park: Public hearing regarding an ordinance amending Planned Development Ordinance 007-034, as amended previously amended , which zones that area of the Town known as Vitruvian Park, containing approximately 121 acres of land generally located at the southeast corner of Marsh Lane and Spring Valley Road in order to add veterinary clinics to the list of allowed uses.

The following public hearings will take place at the City Council Meeting on Wednesday, February 20 at Addison Town Hall. The [Council agenda](#) will be posted on the Town's website three days prior to the meeting.

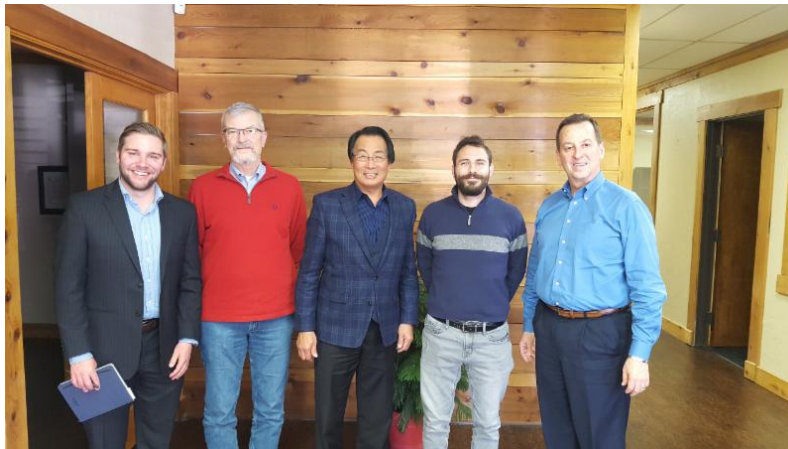
Case 1789-SUP/Sunny Street Cafe: Public Hearing to approve an ordinance changing the zoning on property located at 14380 Marsh Lane Suite H, which is currently zoned PD, Planned Development, through Ordinances 007-034, O16-017, and O16-018, by approving a Special Use Permit for a restaurant only.

Case 1790-Z/Town of Addison: Public Hearing to approve an amendment to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan in order to adopt the findings of the Addison Circle Special Area Study.

Master Plan Belt Line 1.5 Beautification: Public Hearing to approve a resolution to adopt the Master Plan developed for Belt Line 1.5 Beautification between Marsh Lane and Midway Road.

On Thursday, February 7, Mayor Joe Chow, Director of Economic Development and Tourism Orlando Campos, and Economic Development Manager Wilson Kerr visited with Life Warmer's executive team: CEO Rick Thomson, CFO Bob Schnitzius, and Project Engineering Manager Shant Aghyarian. 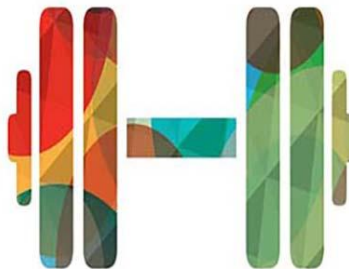
WaterTower Theatre Presents: *Guadalupe in the Guest Room*

DART Launches New Transportation Assistance Program for Addison Residents



DART Rides announced this week that they have expanded their transportation assistance program for those who are 65 years old or over or have a qualified disability to the 75001 zip code. The service is subsidized 75%, so the rider only pays 25% of the cost. The DART Rides Program operates seven days a week from 5am until 11pm, the same hours as DART buses, trains, and paratransit services.
