Council Updates

Council Discusses Draft Economic Development Strategic Plan

In the spring of 2018, the City Council approved a contract with Ady Advantage and Gateway Planning for the development of a new Economic Development Strategic Plan. The previous plan was adopted in 2010, and all of the goals have been achieved. Ady Advantage evaluated the community by conducting an in-depth demographic analysis and interviews with local executives, key stakeholders, Council Members, and residents. Ady Advantage also conducted an online survey to seek feedback from the community. Their work has been synthesized into a draft Economic Development Strategic Plan. Ady Advantage along with Gateway Planning have developed a new vision, set of new goals, and tactics as part of their recommendations for the plan.

The consultants presented the draft plan to Council at a Special Council Work Session on Thursday, March 14 and requested their feedback and direction.

The final plan will be brought back to Council for consideration at a future meeting. Once the plan is adopted, the Economic Development and Tourism Department will begin work on the implementation of the plan's goals and tactics which will provide a roadmap for Addison's continued economic growth and prosperity.

Addison Police Department Submits Grant Request for Assistance with Record Management System/NIBRS Conversion Project

In November of 2018, the Addison Police Department was notified by the State of Texas, Officer of the Governor, of their eligibility to receive a grant designated to enable local law enforcement agencies to upgrade their technology infrastructure to allow for and support the submission of data to the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) and National Incident Based System (NIBRS). It is the goal of the State of Texas that all police departments make this change by September 1, 2019 and will be mandatory by the FBI in 2021.

As is required by the grant application procedures, Council approved a <u>resolution</u> at its March 12 City Council Meeting approving submission of the grant application and authorizing the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant.

The grant funds will offset costs associated with Addison's current Record Management System (RMS) project to collect and process data that can be submitted to the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) UCR Program in the NIBRS format.

DART is holding a series of community meetings to review the progress of the Cotton Belt Corridor Regional Rail Project. Members of the Design-Pre-Construction Management Team will be on hand to outline the latest developments and answer your questions.
