Council Updates

Council Gets Update on Airport Southeast Quadrant Redevelopment







Council approved a ground lease with Black Forest Aviation (BFA) at the <u>December 11</u>, <u>2018 City Council Meeting</u>. At the April 9 Council meeting, Assistant Director of Development Services Charles Goff gave Council an update on the project that calls for a three-hangar Fixed Base Operator (FBO) operated by Galaxy Aviation on Addison Road across the street from Addison Circle. BFA completed Phase I and II environmental site assessments in mid-February and the Airport is preparing a remediation plan. The inspection period ends on April 12, 2019 or upon acceptance of the remediation plan, whichever is later. BFA anticipates construction to start late Summer 2019.

Council Adopts Standards of Care Ordinance for Addison Athletic Club Youth Camps

At the April 9 meeting, Council held a public hearing before adopting this year's <u>ordinance</u> that defines standards of care for all youth programs for children ages 5 through 13 at the Addison Athletic Club.

The Texas Human Resources Code requires that each year Addison adopt an ordinance establishing minimum standards for operating youth programs which include program staff hiring guidelines, enrollment guidelines, discipline, health, safety, and more. The ordinance also addresses programing and providing activities that promote emotional, social, and mental growth.

The Addison Athletic Club not only complies with the minimum standards required in the state's ordinance, but exceeds some of the established standards. Some examples include:

- · Video monitoring throughout the facility and in all child care areas.
- Day Camp Restroom Policy which requires campers to use the single use child care
 restroom or upstairs single use restrooms. This prevents campers from utilizing the
 locker rooms. This policy also requires campers changing into swim suits to use the
 outdoor pool restroom prior to the pool being open to the general public.

Registration for Short-Term Rentals Begins May 1

Beginning on May 1, all short-term rental operators will be required to register and apply for a short-term rental (STR) permit with the Town of Addison.

Any residential property or portion of a property that is rented out on a short-term basis – for a period of fewer than 30 days – is considered to be a short-term rental. This includes homes that are listed for rent on Airbnb, VRBO Vacation Rentals, HomeAway, and similar websites.

On March 12, 2019, the City Council established regulations for short-term rentals. The ordinance does not prohibit short-term rentals, but it does allow the Town to monitor short-term rental properties and set certain standards in order to protect the integrity of Addison neighborhoods and the safety of the community.

Interested in Serving on an Art and Design Committee for the New Addison DART Transit Center?

In December 2018, DART awarded a contract to Archer Western Herzog Joint Venture (AWH) for the design and construction of the Cotton Belt Regional Rail Project. While some station design elements will be consistent in each station, other features, such as a public art, will also be selected so that each station reflects its community.

DART has proposed using an Art and Design Committee to provide input on these unique design elements and has requested that the Town provide 8-14 individuals to make up Addison's Art and Design Committee. DART estimates the process will include five committee workshops over four months. These meetings are anticipated to start in July of 2019 and will take place in the evenings.

Property owners and tenants along Midway Road who will be impacted by the Midway Road Reconstruction Project were invited to an Open House on Wednesday, April 10 to get a project update. The design of the project, which includes replacing the road from Spring Valley Road to Keller Springs Road, utility replacement, and incorporation of the Master Transportation Plan elements, is 90% complete. There will be other opportunities in the fall to get more information. Construction is slated to begin in early 2020.
