### Council Update

#### City Manager Submits Proposed Fiscal Year 2020 Budget to Council

Addison City Manager Wes Pierson shared his [proposed budget](#) for Fiscal Year 2020 with the City Council on July 31, as is required by Addison's Charter.

Over the next two months, there will be several opportunities for the public to participate in the budget process. The City Council will hold Budget Work Sessions on August 15 and August 16 at the Addison Conference Centre to discuss the proposed budget. Since it is applied in a semi-liquid form, the hydraulic limestone does not set immediately when applied, allowing the applicators to carve and texturize the wall to suit the specific vision of their customers. StoneCoat is a rapidly growing company that now has offices throughout the United States, as well as Dubai, Canada, Egypt, Ukraine, and India.
