# **Council Update**

### Council Gets Refresher on Texas Election Code and Political Advertising in Preparation for the November 5 Bond Election

During a work session on August 13, Director of Public Works Lisa Pyles gave Council an update on the Texas Election Code as it relates to Political Advertising. The Texas Election Code regulates the Council's ability to advocate for an election outcome - including a bond election.

Mrs. Pyles reminded Council what qualifies as public funds expenditures, permitted and prohibited communication, prohibited activities, and communications rules. She also reminded Council about the communications channels and tools that could be used to inform the public about the November 5 bond election.
