Council Update

Joint Meeting with City Council and P&Z

There will be a joint meeting with City Council and the Planning and Zoning Commission on Tuesday, October 1 from 6pm - 8pm at the Addison TreeHouse (14681 Midway Road). A [full agenda will be posted here](#) three days prior to the meeting.

Council to Appoint Charter Review Commission

Addison's Home Rule Charter requires a Charter Review Commission be appointed at least every ten years to review the Town's Charter. A Commission was last appointed in December 2009. At its September 10 work session, City Secretary Irma Parker reviewed the Charter Review Commission membership appointment process and timeline with Council.

Every appointee must be a resident and each Council Member can appoint up to two people to the commission. If you are interested in being considered to serve on the Charter Review Commission, [you can apply here](#) .

Once the commission submits a final report, Council can add changes for consideration and make a decision whether or not to call an election.



On Thursday, September 19, DART celebrated the ground breaking of the 26-mile Silver Line with events in Plano, Richardson, Dallas, Addison, and Carrollton. The Silver Line will connect Plano through Addison to DFW Airport. At the airport, the line will connect with the TEXRail in Terminal B and continue to downtown Fort Worth.

Mayor Joe Chow, Mayor Pro Tempore Tom Braun, Deputy Mayor Pro Tempore Lori Ward and Council Members Ivan Hughes, Guillermo Quintanilla, Paul Walden and Marlin Willesen joined members of the DART Board, former Addison elected officials, and current and former Addison staff to mark this important occasion at the Addison Transit Center. Elected officials from the cities along the Silver Line, together with members of the DART Board and many of the people who championed the Cotton Belt project, gathered for a luncheon at the DFW Hyatt Regency to celebrate this regional effort.

Thank you to everyone who has contributed to making this project a reality, from current and past elected officials to current and past staff to residents who attended DART Board meetings in yellow shirts. We look forward to celebrating the opening of the new station in 2022 with great fanfare.

Oncor crews will be replacing a switchgear located at Belt Line Road and Surveyor Boulevard on Tuesday, September 24. This switchgear feeds much of the Midway Meadows neighborhood (see highlighted map for impacted area) and the work will result in an outage from 9am - 1pm. Oncor placed door hangers on residences that will be affected on Thursday, September 19.

Unified Development Code Community Meeting



Addison is in the process of a comprehensive review of the Town's development regulations. Many of the Town's rules for development were crafted in the 1980s and may not be keeping up with current development trends, shifting demographics, and evolving consumer preferences or current and future community needs. To accomplish this review, the Town is working with consulting firm, Clarion Associates. Clarion has completed a draft of Part 1 of 3 of the new Unified Development Code (UDC), which includes zoning districts, use regulations, and definitions sections, and would like the community's input.
