COVID-19 Update

On December 30, Dallas County Health and Human Services (DCHHS) reported 2,292 additional positive cases of COVID-19 for a cumulative total of 170,747 confirmed cases, including 1,611 confirmed deaths. According to Dallas County Judge Clay Jenkins, hospital numbers are at all-time highs and the availability of ICU beds in the region is at an all-time low. "Currently, one in four persons hospitalized in Dallas County has COVID and approximately 30 percent of those hospitalized in the region have COVID," said Judge Jenkins in a December 29 press release.

The last summary posted on the DCHHS website is from December 11 and shows Addison has a total of 628 confirmed COVID-19 cases. DCHHS releases typically releases new numbers every Tuesday and Friday and reports can be found on their website here.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is asking people to celebrate the new year at home with the people who live with them or virtually with friends and family. Find more CDC recommendations for New Year's Eve and holiday travel here.

The Town of Addison is taking action to prevent the spread of COVID-19. We would like to encourage everyone to join us. The CDC has encouraged the community to practice social distancing, but also to follow these steps to minimize the spread of any disease:

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and help young children do the same. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
