Council Update

No Council Meeting Next Week

During its October 26 meeting, the City Council discussed its calendar for the next few months. As they historically do, Council has canceled its second November Council meeting (November 23) and its second December meeting (December 28) due to the holidays.

It's Time for a New Citizen Satisfaction Survey

Addison has engaged ETC Institute to complete a new citizen satisfaction survey. The <u>last</u> <u>citizen survey</u> was completed in 2018. ETC Institute will mail the survey and a cover letter (on Town letterhead) to a random sample of 400 households in Addison. These households are picked based on geographical locations to equally represent the Town and return statistically significant results. Residents who receive the survey will have the option of returning the printed survey by mail in a postage-paid envelope or completing it online.

If you are one of the residents who receives the survey, we encourage you to invest a few minutes in your responses. Your responses will help guide many of the decisions that will

be made about the Town's future.


The Community Partners Bureau is comprised of residents appointed by the Council to represent the Town of Addison with its Community Partners (non-profit organizations). Council will be considering the following liaison appointments:

- Dallas Cat Lady: Dallas Cat Lady has been working since 2006 to find good homes for cats and kittens. They work with local shelters to give cats and kittens more time to find just the right home. They have placed over 3,000 cats and kittens with new families.
- The Family Place: The Family Place has been helping victims of family violence in North Texas since 1978. They provide everything needed to help victims become survivors.
- Woven Health Clinic: Woven Health Clinic provides primary health care services for people who live in Addison, Carrollton, Coppell, Farmers Branch, and northwest Dallas who cannot afford healthcare.

Around Addison

Belt Line Road Reduced to One Lane in Each Direction on Sunday, November 21



On Sunday, November 21 from 5:30am - 8pm, **Belt Line Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction just east of Quorum Drive** to allow for the installation of the base and fame of a new electronic sign. The sign, which was approved as part of the 2012 bond election, will replace the vinyl banners that are currently used to promote special events. If work is not completed on Sunday, lanes may need to be closed again from 9am - noon on Monday, November 22.

Athletic Club Renovations Begin After Thanksgiving Holiday



As part of the 2019 bond election, Addison residents approved a proposition that would give the Athletic Club some needed cosmetic and functional upgrades. In <u>October 2021</u>, the City Council awarded the construction contract for the project to Northridge Construction Group and Town staff has recently given the green light to the contractor for construction to begin. Work will start immediately after the Thanksgiving holiday and is slated to be completed by the end of July 2022. However, it is anticipated that the schedule may be extended if alternate bid items are awarded during construction or unforeseen issues are identified.

On Monday, November 29, Northridge will begin staging equipment, including construction trailers, in the parking lot of the club. The indoor pool will be closed beginning Thursday, December 2 and the locker rooms will be closed beginning December 7. **Both the indoor pool and the locker rooms will remain closed for the majority of the renovation.**

Portable restroom trailers will be placed in the Club's parking lot as long as the locker rooms are closed. These restrooms have toilets and sinks, are climate controlled, and offer an ADA-compatible option. However, they do not have shower facilities.

Although the building will remain open to members, closures to parts of the club, including the main entrance, atrium, and fitness areas, will be required periodically throughout the duration of the project. You can find a summary of the project improvements on the <u>project</u> website.
