**Council Update**

**Happy Thanksgiving**



Town offices, including the Athletic Club, will be closed for the Thanksgiving holiday on Thursday, November 25 and Friday, November 26. If you need assistance over the holiday, please call the non-emergency public safety number at 972-450-7156.

Since Thanksgiving falls on a regularly scheduled trash collection day, CWD has postponed service until Friday, November 26. Please place your trash by the curb by 7am on November 26.

### **Application Deadline for Boards, Commissions, and Community Partners is November 30**

If you are interested in applying for a position on the Planning and Zoning Commission or Board of Zoning Adjustment, or as a Community Partner, please [fill out this application](#).

The Community Partners Bureau is comprised of residents appointed by the Council to represent the Town of Addison with its Community Partners (non-profit organizations). Council will be considering the following liaison appointments:

- Dallas Cat Lady: Dallas Cat Lady has been working since 2006 to find good homes for cats and kittens. They work with local shelters to give cats and kittens more time to find just the right home. They have placed over 3,000 cats and kittens with new families.
- The Family Place: The Family Place has been helping victims of family violence in North Texas since 1978. They provide everything needed to help victims become survivors.
- Woven Health Clinic: Woven Health Clinic provides primary health care services for people who live in Addison, Carrollton, Coppell, Farmers Branch, and northwest Dallas who cannot afford healthcare.

### Athletic Club Renovations Begin After Thanksgiving Holiday



On Monday, November 29, the contractor selected for the Athletic Club renovations will begin staging equipment, including construction trailers, in the parking lot of the club. The indoor pool will be closed beginning Thursday, December 2 and the locker rooms will be closed beginning Tuesday, December 7. ***Both the indoor pool and the locker rooms will remain closed for the majority of the renovation.***

A portable restroom trailer will be placed in the Club's parking lot as long as the locker rooms are closed. These restrooms have toilets and sinks, are climate controlled, and offer an ADA-compatible option. However, they do not have shower facilities.

Although the building will remain open to members, closures to parts of the club, including the main entrance, atrium, and fitness areas, will be required periodically throughout the duration of the project. You can find a summary of the project improvements on the [project website](#).
