Council Update

COVID-19 Vaccine Update



Texans over the age of 50 who did not qualify for the COVID-19 vaccine in the state's phases 1A and 1B became eligible on Monday, March 15. According to the Texas Department of State Health Services, there are about 5 million Texans between the ages of 50 and 64, and the state estimates about 1 million have already been vaccinated.

UT Southwestern (UTSW) announced this week that they opened a new COVID-19 vaccine site at the University of Texas at Dallas in Richardson. Vaccines are administered by UTSW personnel and will be given to those on the UTSW waitlist. UTSW patients can register through their MyChart app and the general public who meet Phase 1A or 1B criteria, or who are at risk of becoming severely ill from COVID-19, can register here.

Oncor Tower Replacement Update

Oncor is now in the restoration phase of its tower replacement project and has contractors working to repair construction damage to park elements in the Redding Trail Corridor. The following work is ongoing or is being scheduled:

- Damage to the concrete trail that occurred during construction and rerouting a small portion of the concrete trail that was impacted by the placement of the new towers is underway. The concrete work is 50% complete and should be finished the week of March 29.
- The sprinkler crews are working on repairing construction damage that occurred to the irrigation system. Repair work began at the Dog Park and is moving west.
- Earthwork to restore the grade and prepare the soil for sod is ongoing and will follow along behind the sprinkler repairs.
- The restoration work is progressing as expected, barring any unforeseen weather delays.

Representatives from Oncor will be discussing this project, along with the company's winter storm response, at the <u>March 23 City Council Work Session</u>.

Follow CDC Social Distancing Guidelines



The Town of Addison is taking action to prevent the spread of COVID-19. We would like to encourage everyone to join us. The CDC has encouraged the community to practice social distancing, but also to follow these steps to minimize the spread of any disease:

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and help young children do the same. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. If you do not have a tissue, use your sleeve (not your hands).
