

# Electronic Belt Line Road Sign Base to be Installed June 7

Addison is planning to install the Belt Line Road electronic sign base Monday, June 7 through Tuesday, June 8, weather permitting. Funding for the sign, which will be located just east of Quorum Drive across from the Magic Time Machine, was approved by voters in the 2012 bond election and will replace the vinyl banners used to promote Addison events. Crews are planning to begin working around 6pm on Monday and work through the night. They anticipate being complete by 5:45am on Tuesday. Expect to see several lane closures during the installation.

## Addison Environmental Health Division Offers Free Mosquito Dunks to Help Residents Control Mosquitoes

Here's your Weekly Update from the Town of Addison, 6.4.21



To help Addison residents reduce the number of mosquitoes on their property, the Addison Environmental Health Division is giving away free Mosquito Dunks® to residents. Mosquito Dunks® are small, donut-shaped objects that float on the surface of the standing water and release bacteria that kill mosquito larvae in the water before they become adults. A single dunk will treat an area of about 100 square feet.

Mosquito Dunks® will be available, free of charge, for pickup at the Addison Athletic Club (3900 Beltway Drive) and the Addison Service Center (16801 Westgrove Drive). There is a two-package per household limit and we have extended the pick-up date to June 11.

#### **Redding Trail Update**

Here's your Weekly Update from the Town of Addison, 6.4.21



Oncor has completed its work for the tower replacement project along Redding Trail. Parks crews have installed the light poles and new drinking fountains, replaced the masonry plinth and the trash receptacles along the trail, and restored the plaque. Staff is awaiting delivery of replacement pet waste stations and two light poles that were damaged, and once these items are received they will be installed. Parks crews are also working to replace shrubs, plantings, and turf that died during the winter storm or were damaged as part of the tower replacement project. This work will be ongoing through the fall months.

The Town has hired an engineer to develop a plan for drainage improvements along the trail where homes along Canot Lane abut the trail corridor. Ligustrum shrubs that were severely impacted by the unusually low temperatures in February are in the process of being removed so survey work along the property line can be completed. Shrubs will be replanted in conjunction with the drainage improvement project that is anticipated to take place in the fall. Residents who live on Canot Lane adjacent to the trail will be invited to a meeting to review plans once the engineer has developed concept plans.



# Athletic Club Doors to Get an Upgrade

The doors at the Addison Athletic Club are being updated to include automatic closure devices. Not only will the new enhancements make the doors Americans with Disabilities (ADA) compliant, but they also provide a touch-free option for guests. The work, which will begin June 11 and take approximately a week to complete, will involve cutting and patching the concrete around the front entrance. During this period, members will be directed to enter through the gymnasium doors.
