Council Update

Council and P&Z Discuss Unified Development Code at Joint Meeting

At the June 17, 2021, Joint City Council and Planning and Zoning Commission meeting, the Town reinitiated the Unified Development Code (UDC) project, continuing strategic efforts to review and modernize the Town's development regulations.

The UDC drafting and review process is comprised of four code drafting phases, a testing phase, and public review and adoption of the consolidated UDC document. The four code drafting phases include:

- Phase I: Zoning Districts and Uses
- Phase II: Development and Design Standards
- Phase III: Administration and Procedures
- Phase IV: Signs and Communication Facilities

The Town is currently reviewing the Development Standards phase (Phase II) of the project. At the June 17 meeting, Council and Commission members provided feedback on the first of three parts of this phase, addressing flood prevention, grading and drainage, and access and circulation. For the July 22 meeting, Town staff and the project consultant,

Clarion Associates, presented the second part of the Development Standards phase, which consisted of parking and loading, site and building design, and exterior lighting standards.

There will be a UDC Community Open House on August 25 so the public can learn more about the proposed changes to the zoning districts, allowed uses, and development standards addressing parking, landscaping, exterior building design, and outdoor lighting. 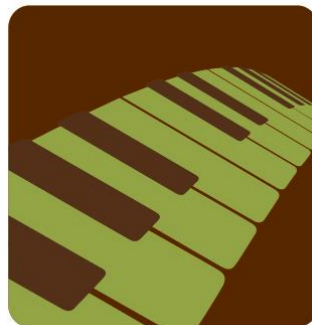

There's a stunning new addition at the Addison water tower located at the corner of Arapaho Road and Surveyor Boulevard that was installed on Thursday, July 23. Russ Connell and Kelsea Lyon created the gold stainless steel sculpture that stands 16 feet tall (including a 3-foot base). The installation, which has not yet been named, is the 19th public artwork sponsored by the Addison Arbor Foundation.
