Officials at the Parkland Center for Clinical Innovation (PCCI), a nonprofit that tracks health data for the county, said <u>in a statement Wednesday, July 8</u> that Dallas County reached the herd immunity threshold on July 4. This threshold is made up of 46.6 percent of the total population being vaccinated and 48.7 percent of the population with natural immunity having recovered from being infected by COVID-19.

According to the statement, while the whole community on average reached the 80 percent mark, there are only 49 ZIP codes above the 80 percent threshold with 45 ZIP codes still below. There are still significant pockets in the community that remain vulnerable. Dallas County Health and Human Services and PCCI recently launched a <u>COVID-19 Vaccination and Herd Immunity Dashboard</u>. The dashboard provides exclusive data for Dallas County, including herd immunity by the percentage of the county's population at the ZIP code level.

Addison is one of only four cities in Dallas County with adult COVID-19 vaccination rates that exceed 75%. We could not have reached this milestone without working as a community to spread the word to our families, friends, and neighbors. <u>CBS DFW's recent</u> <u>story</u> celebrates the success of cities like ours but also highlights that there is still work to be done.

#### **Overnight Work Planned at Midway/Proton July 9 - 10**



As the reconstruction of the utility lines along Midway Road progresses, additional night work is required to minimize the impact on traffic and surrounding business. Crews have been working at the Belt Line Road and Midway Road intersection at night for the last few weeks to install the new waterline components for the project.

From Friday, July 9 at 7pm to 5am on Saturday, July 10, crews will be completing the underground work at Proton Drive and Midway Road. Expect dump truck traffic and compaction equipment noise during these overnight hours while crews fill the large excavation on the southwest corner of Proton and Midway.
