**Council Update** 

**Dallas County Removes Mask Mandate Penalty** 



On Sunday, August 15, the Texas Supreme Court temporarily restricted Dallas County Judge Clay Jenkins' ability to enforce a mask mandate in schools and businesses. In response to the court's <u>Stay Order</u>, which temporarily blocks the mask mandate until the entire case can be heard on August 24, Judge Jenkins has <u>amended his Executive Order</u> to remove the penalties for businesses that do not comply.

Addison is continuing to monitor the rapidly changing and ongoing legal conflict on this matter. Once it has reached its final conclusion, we are prepared to respond accordingly.

The health of our community continues to be a top priority, so in the meantime, we are encouraging members of the public to wear masks as they deem appropriate, wash hands or use hand sanitizer frequently, practice social distancing as necessary, and to stay home when sick. Redding Trail Drainage Project Public Input Meeting

#### **Belt Line Road Electronic Sign Update**

While Addison has seen progress on the Belt Line Road electronic sign, the project is slightly behind schedule due to the impact of the February freeze and COVID-19-related materials shortages. To date, the engineering, permitting and utility location has been completed, the foundation has been poured, and the electronic display units and pedestal have been manufactured and are awaiting installation. Over the next three weeks, the contractor will form and pour concrete for the traffic barriers and pedestal. The steel frame fabrication is slated to be completed the beginning of October and will be erected the middle of October, weather permitting. Installation is slated to be complete the end of October with an anticipated "go live" date the beginning of November.
