Council Update

Council Discusses Fiscal Year 2022 Proposed Budget

On Wednesday, August 4, the City Council held a Budget Work Session at the Addison TreeHouse to review the <u>City Manager's Proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Budget</u> in detail and discuss the FY2022 proposed tax rate. They were scheduled to have a second Work Session on August 5 but opted to cancel it when they wrapped up discussions at the August 4 meeting. Council is scheduled to hold public hearings for the FY2022 budget and tax rate on September 7 and September 14. Rating Agencies Confirm Addison's Top Ratings

On July 22, <u>Moody's Investors Services announced</u> that they are reaffirming Addison's Aaa issuer rating and providing a stable outlook. Per their release, the rationale for the rating includes that the town's ample reserves have remained intact throughout the

ongoing health pandemic, supported by an adept management team that uses conservative practices to guide budget planning and execution.

Additionally, <u>S&P Global reaffirmed Addison's AAA rating</u> and providing a stable outlook, the highest rating awarded by the agency, on July 27. Addison is one of only 10 cities in Texas with top ratings for both Moody's and S&P.
