# **Upcoming Public Hearings**

The following Public Hearings will take place at the October 11 City Council Meeting at the Addison TreeHouse (14681 Midway Road). The meeting is scheduled to begin at 7:30pm and the full agenda will be <u>posted on the Town's website</u> three days prior.

<u>Case 1849-SUP/15375 Addison Road (Ambrosia Café).</u> Hold a Public Hearing on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance approving a Special Use Permit (SUP) for property located at 15375 Addison Road, that is currently zoned Local Retail (LR) to allow a restaurant.

<u>Case 1855-SUP/14380 Marsh Lane, Suite 100 (Jeremiah's Italian Ice).</u> Hold a Public Hearing on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance approving a Special Use Permit (SUP) for property located at 14380 Marsh Lane, Suite 100 that is currently zoned Planned Development (PD) through Ordinance Nos. O16-017 and O16-018 to allow a restaurant with a drive-thru.

<u>Case 1856-Z/4150 Beltway Drive (Addison Reserve Townhomes).</u> Hold a Public Hearing on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance adopting a development plan for the Addison Reserve Townhomes, including a site plan, landscape plan, lighting plan, façade plans, and floor plans for 31 townhomes and associated public open space and common area lots in an existing Planned Development (PD) through Ordinance O22-08, situated on approximately 1.804 acres located at 4150 Beltway Drive. <u>Case 1858-SUP/14380 Marsh Lane, Suite 160 (Buttermilk Biscuits Brunch House)</u>. Hold a Public Hearing on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance approving a Special Use Permit (SUP) for property located at 14380 Marsh Lane, Suite 160 that is currently zoned Planned Development (PD) through Ordinance Nos. O16-017 and O16-018 to allow a restaurant with the Sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption.

### **Be Aware of Possible Lane Closures**


