Council Updates

The following Public Hearings will take place at the November 8 City Council Meeting at the Addison TreeHouse (14681 Midway Road). The meeting is scheduled to begin at 7:30pm and the full agenda will be [posted on the Town's website](#) three days prior.

Case 1859-SUP/5100 Belt Line Road, Suite #430 (Hawkers): Hold a Public Hearing, on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance approving a Special Use Permit (SUP) for property located at 5100 Belt Line Road, Suite #430 that is currently zoned Planned Development (PD), through Ordinance Nos. O12-002 and O20-08, to allow a restaurant with the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption.

Case 1862-Z /18 Runyon Road: Hold a Public Hearing on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance amending Planned Development (PD) District Ordinance No. 016-003 for a 0.552-acre segment of a property located east of the Intersection of Runyon Road and Magnolia Street, in order to modify Use Regulations by allowing offsite parking lot as a permitted use.

Case 1863-Z /14951 Midway Road (Nate's Seafood & Steakhouse): Hold a Public Hearing on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance amending the Development Plans for Planned Development (PD) District Ordinance No. 446 for a 0.945-acre property located

at 14951 Midway Road, to account for site modifications resulting from the acquisition of Right-of-Way for the Midway Road Reconstruction Project.

Construction Update

Winnwood Bridge Drainage Project Update



This summer Addison Public Works began construction to repair/rehabilitate the existing Winnwood Road Bridge drainage outfall to prevent future damage to the bridge due to potential erosion issues. The contractor completed installing concrete riprap material and placing rock gabion baskets along the channel bottom of the creek this month. They have also completed demolishing the damaged portion of the existing sidewalk and will replace it with new concrete along the beginning of the trail near Belt Line Road and Winnwood Road.

Over the next two weeks, the contractor will be working on planting and irrigation replacement, stone riprap placement along one side of the eroding stream bank, general site clean-up, and finally restoring the site to its original condition. If weather permits, the final project completion and closeout are expected by the end of November.

Section of Beltway Drive Screening Wall to be Removed for Utility Work on November 7



InTown Homes will remove a 60-foot section of the Beltway Drive screening wall on Monday, November 7 in order to facilitate the extension of a required water line and to install the emergency access driveway and retractable bollards at the restricted access connection between Beltway Drive and Magnolia Street in the Addison Grove development.

Work will commence on November 7 and is projected to be completed by InTown Homes on December 13. Key project milestones include:

- Removal of a 60-foot segment of the screening wall (Monday, November 7).
- Potholing of Beltway to locate existing utilities and boring of Beltway for new water line connection (Tuesday, November 8 – Friday, November 11).
- Install water line connection, chlorinate, pressure test, and backfill trench (Monday, November 14 – Monday, November 21).
- Install and inspect retractable bollards (Monday, November 28 – Monday, December 5).
- Test subgrade and install permanent pavement (Tuesday, December 6 – Thursday, December 8).
- Remove pavement forms and repair landscape (Friday, December 9 – Tuesday, December 13).

While work is ongoing, a temporary chain link construction fence will be utilized to provide the required access to the construction site. Solutions for a more permanent construction debris barrier will be identified and installed following the completion of the work.

The contractor will stage project-related vehicles, equipment, and materials north of the screening wall and limit construction impacts on Beltway Drive as much as possible. DART offering Free Rides to the Polls on Election Day

Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) is providing free transportation to polling locations on Election Day. Voters can ride at no charge on all DART buses, trains, the Dallas Streetcar, GoLink, Paratransit Services, and the TRE between EBJ Union Station and CentrePort/DFW Airport Station. No proof of voter registration is required to ride for free on November 8. 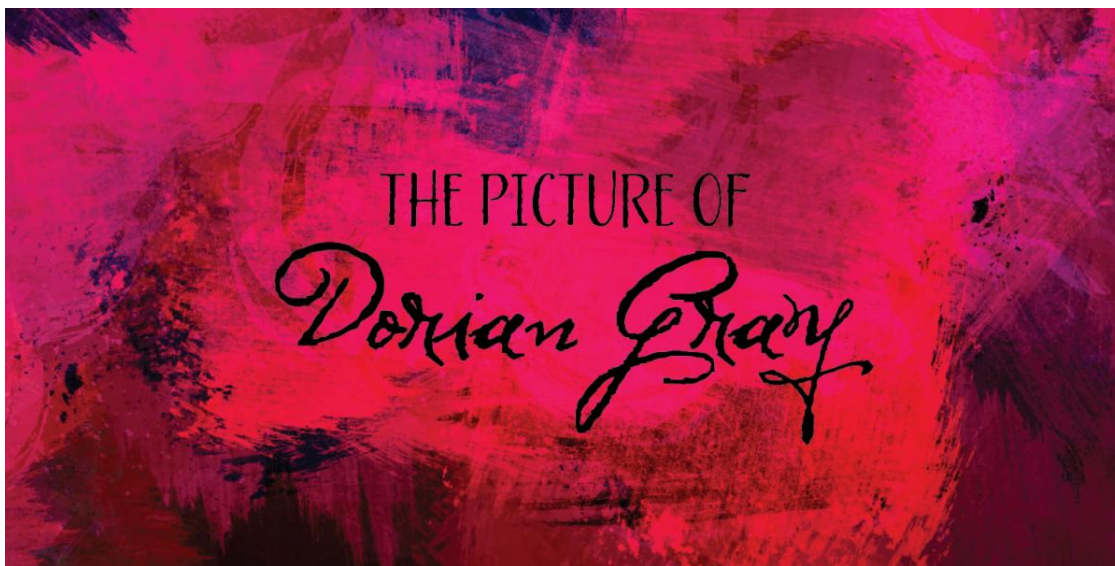
North Dallas Chamber of Commerce Hosts Aviation Breakfast
