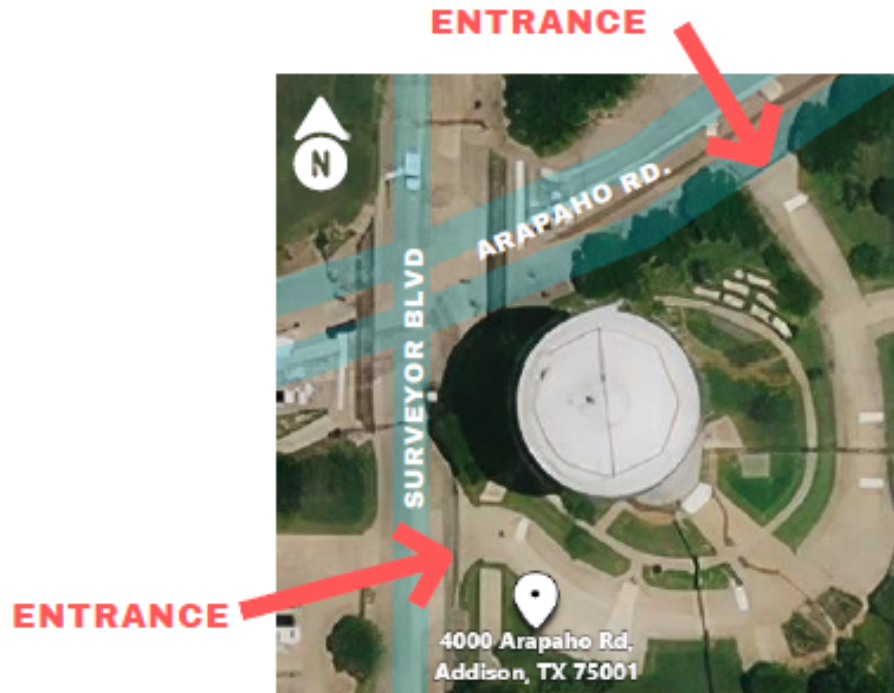

Notice Yellow Granules at Our Parks?



The Addison Parks and Recreation Department has been receiving questions about the yellow granules people are seeing in the turf at our parks lately. This is corn gluten that the Parks crews uses around all playgrounds, lawn areas where kids play, and in dog parks. Corn gluten is non-toxic and is often used as a filler in some pet foods. It is also an organic pre-emergent herbicide that helps prevent weed seed germination.

Many Athletic Club Programs/Classes to Move to Surveyor Water Tower on February 21



Beginning Monday, February 21, many Athletic Club classes and programs will be moving to a classroom in the base of the Surveyor Water Tower. This water tower is located at the corner of Surveyor Boulevard and Arapaho Road at 4000 Arapaho Road. (Please note that this is not the same as the WaterTower Theatre.)

Parking is available in a gated lot at the water tower but is limited. Athletic Club staff will be directing members in the parking lot before classes and programs begin. However, members are encouraged to carpool.

Registration will not be available at the water tower. If there is a fee associated with the program/class, you must register in advance at the Athletic Club. Those who want to take aerobics classes should purchase or renew their punch pass at the Athletic Club. Drop-in fees will not be accepted at the water tower.

Midway Road Project Update



Demolition and removal of the paving on Midway Road have begun along the northbound lanes from Spring Valley Road to Proton Drive. Private utility line adjustments and storm sewer system improvements are currently underway. The next major activity for this phase will be the final grading and subgrade stabilization in preparation for the installation of the new concrete pavement.

Please pay close attention as you travel through the area - traffic patterns will be changing frequently.
