Upcoming Public Hearings

The following public hearing will take place at the March 8 City Council Meeting. The agenda [will be posted](#) three days prior to the meeting.

Case 1846-Z/4150 Beltway Drive (Addison Reserve Townhomes): Hold a Public Hearing on a recommendation regarding an Ordinance changing the zoning for a 1.804-acre property located at 4150 Beltway Drive, from Planned Development (PD) through Ordinance 083-039, to a new PD District to allow a townhome development comprised of 33 townhome lots and associated open space and common area lots.

Public Safety Update

Addison Police Department and Athletic Club Hosted Crime Prevention Workshop



On Tuesday, March 1 the Addison Athletic Club and Addison Police Department teamed up to host a Crime Prevention Workshop at the Surveyor Water Tower. Officer Biggs presented several ways to reduce your own risk of victimization using tools that are easily accessible. While the list of crime prevention measures you can take is very long, here are a few simple things that anyone can do:

1. Invest in visible cameras for your property. Ring, Nest, Arlo, and SimpliSafe are just a few reputable brands that are simple to install.
2. Install exterior lights and leave them on at night. Let people know that they cannot enter your property without being seen.
3. Replace the factory screws in the strike plates of exterior doors with 3-inch wood screws. These sink into the framing studs and are much better at preventing unwanted entry.
4. Share these tips with your neighbors! Prevention is a group effort, and if the entire community is well-lit, well-monitored, and well-secured, it presents a strong deterrent to crime.

Total Closure of Addison Road at the DART Rail Crossing Planned for March 18 - 21



DART's contractor Archer Western Herzog is in the process of replacing the rail line and concrete pavement approaches to the railroad crossing at Addison Road. Finishing the project will require a complete lane closure of all north bound and south bound lanes of Addison Road between Arapaho Road and Lindbergh Drive from 9pm on Friday, March 18 until noon on Monday, March 21. Please pay close attention to the detour signs that will direct you around the construction zone.
