Council Update

Addison Town Meeting - April 14



Make plans to attend the Spring 2022 Town Meeting on Thursday, April 14 at 7pm at the Renaissance Hotel. The City Council will share updates on things taking place around Town. If you can't attend in person, you can watch the meeting on the <u>Town's website</u>.

We will be collecting new and gently used games, toys, and coloring supplies (see list below) for the George Bush Elementary school store at the event. Students earn "Bush" bucks for good behavior and get to redeem them in the student-run Patriot Galleria. This video of some of the student ambassadors gives more background on the project.

Below is a list of the most requested items from their students.

- 1. Games (Checkers, Uno, Connect 4, etc.)

Donations can also be dropped off at Town Hall or either Fire Station through April 15.


Upcoming Public Hearings

The following public hearing will take place at the April 12 City Council Meeting, which will be held at the Addison TreeHouse at 7:30pm. The <u>agenda will be posted</u> three days prior to the meeting.

<u>Case 1843-Z/JPI Addison Heights:</u> Hold a Public Hearing on an Ordinance rezoning a 3.2-acre property located at the southeast corner of Addison Road and Airport Parkway, from Commercial-2 (C-2) to Planned Development (PD) District with modified Urban Center (UC) District standards, to allow a multifamily development comprised of a maximum of 287 Dwelling Units and Live/Work Units, and approximately 5,000 square feet of future retail space, and to approve related development plans.

This work will require a single lane closure during the day and flaggers will be present.


Annual Easter Eggstravaganza Scheduled for April 9


