Sky Harbor Capital, LLC: Public Hearing regarding the issuance of tax-exempt private activity bonds for the purpose of constructing private executive aircraft hangars. The private activity bonds will be issued by an entity called Public Finance Authority for Sky Harbor Capital, LLC's executive hangar project at the Addison Airport. The private activity bonds do not constitute an obligation or liability of the Town of Addison. ### Addison Athletic Club Renovation Update



The Athletic Club locker rooms are beginning to take shape. Cabinetry and vanity mirrors have been installed and the lockers are next on the list. Painting in the locker rooms has also been completed. In the lobby area, the racquetball court ceiling has been installed and the painting of the lobby is underway. The front desk millwork and lighting are in progress and cabinetry is being installed in the multipurpose room. Some minor repairs are being done to the track walls to prepare for a graphic on the back wall. All the concrete for the hot tub has been poured and the contractor is starting to tile and plaster. The kid's pool water feature was also installed but still needs some tweaks.

### **New Outdoor Pickleball Courts Available for Open Play**

**Expect Park and Road Closures During Addison Kaboom Town!**



Addison Circle Park will be closed from Tuesday, June 28 – Tuesday, July 5 for Kaboom Town set up and tear down. We apologize for any inconvenience and encourage you to visit some of the other parks around Town during this time. You can find a complete list [on the Town's website](#).

Please be aware of the following road closures that will be required during Addison Kaboom Town!:

Parking along **Quorum Drive from Arapaho Road to Morris Avenue** will be prohibited between 2am on Sunday, July 3 and 6am on Monday, July 4

**Festival Way** from Addison Road to Quorum Drive will close June 27 at 9am and will re-open on July 5 by 5pm.

**Addison Circle Drive** from Addison Road to Witt Place will close on June 30 at 8am and will re-open on July 5 by 9am.

**Quorum Drive** from Arapaho Road to Morris Avenue will close on July 3 at 11am and will re-open on July 4 by 12am.

**McEntire Place** west of Lewis Place to Quorum Drive will close on July 3 at 11am and will re-open on July 4 by 12am.

**Spectrum Drive** from Arapaho Road to McEntire Place will close on July 3 at 11am and will re-open on July 4 by 12am.

**Arapaho Road Bridge** will be closed at 12pm on July 3 and will re-open after the fireworks show (approximately 10:30pm).

**Lindbergh Drive** will close at approximately 6pm on July 3 and will re-open after the fireworks show (approximately 10:30pm).

**Please note:** The popularity of the Addison Kaboom Town! fireworks show may cause some traffic delays, specifically following the fireworks show. Travel as directed for a few miles beyond Addison's borders before traveling to your desired location.

### **Texas Homeowners Assistance Grants for Delinquent Property Taxes and Late Mortgage Payments Now Available**

Texas recently launched an \$842 million fund aimed at helping homeowners avoid foreclosure caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Texas Homeowner Assistance Fund is designed for homeowners who have struggled to pay their mortgage, property taxes, home insurance, and home-related fees because of economic hardships caused by the pandemic.

The Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs is administering the monies that were passed as part of the American Rescue Plan. Homeowners may be eligible for up to \$25K for delinquent property taxes on homesteads and can include any accrued court costs, abstract fees, and other suit-related fees.

Basic eligibility guidelines include:

- Late on one or more payments: mortgage, property tax, property insurance, HOA/Condo fees
- Household income at or below 100% Area Median Income (AMI) OR 100% of the median income for the U.S. whichever is greater
- Own and occupy home in Texas as primary residence
- Experienced a qualified financial hardship after January 21, 2020 (lost income or increased expenses resulting from the pandemic)
- Required Documents:
  - approved form of ID (DL, SS card, Military ID, State ID, birth certificate, etc.)



- verified income statement (W2, IRS Form 1099, tax return, pay stub, employer attestation)
- evidence of delinquency (delinquent tax statement, notice from tax attorney, etc.)
