Council Update

Upcoming Public Hearing

The following Public Hearing will take place during the July 12 City Council Meeting which will be held at the Addison TreeHouse at 14681 Midway Road. The agenda will be posted on the [Town's](#) website three days prior to the meeting.

Case 1833-Z/Addison Grove, Block D: Hold a Public Hearing on an Ordinance adopting a Development Plan for Block D of the Addison Grove Addition, including a site plan, landscape plan, building elevations, and floor plans for 54 townhome lots and one open space lot in an existing Planned Development District (PD), through Ordinance O16-003, located on approximately 2.08 acres at the southwest corner of Magnolia Street and Runyon Road, approximately 400 feet south of Belt Line Road.

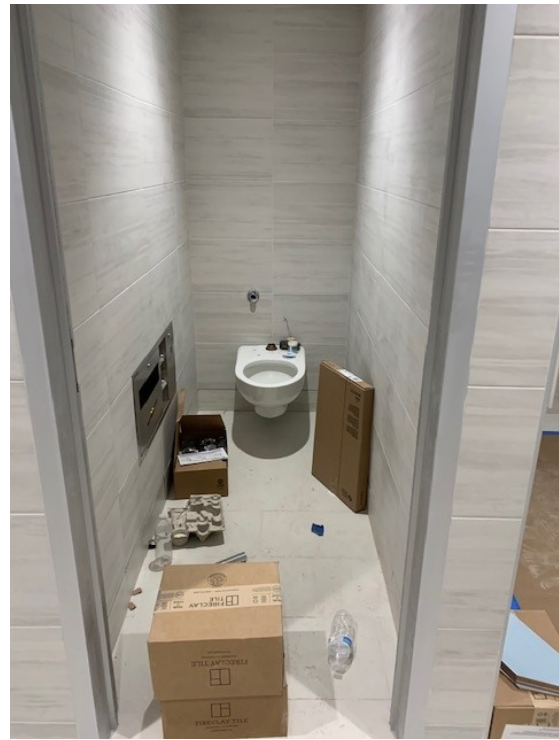
Vitruvian Pond Fountain Repairs Underway



Crews were out on Wednesday, July 6 to remove the water recirculation and fountain pumps at Vitruvian Pond for repairs. All underwater repairs have been completed, and above-water electrical repair work is underway.

There is light at the end of the tunnel for the Athletic Club Renovation Project! Over the last two weeks, there has been a lot of tile being installed in both the lobby and locker rooms. The locker room toilets are also being installed.

The weight room will be closed due to construction at 4pm on Wednesday, July 13, and will remain closed all day on Thursday, July 14. The contractor is going to remove carpet glue, install luxury vinyl flooring, and paint the walls in the stretching area. The basketball gym will be open next Wednesday afternoon and Thursday; however, regularly scheduled fitness classes and programs will take priority in that space. The outdoor pool will be open during normal hours of operation.

We appreciate your continued patience as we reach the final stretch of this renovation project. The project remains on budget and is still on schedule to be substantially completed by the end of July.

Saying Farewell to City Manager Wes Pierson



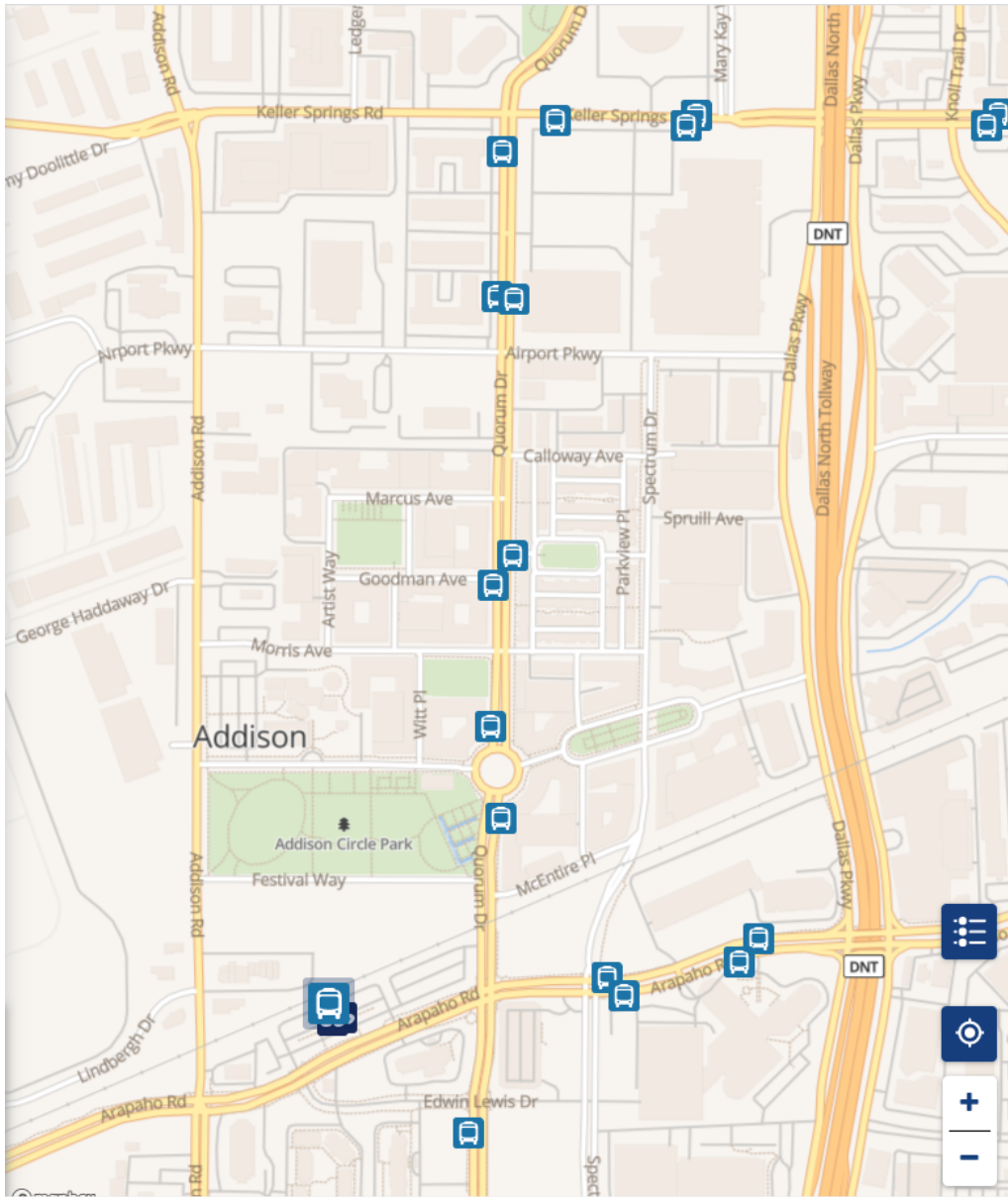

Utility Billing Update to Take Place July 20 - 21

The Town of Addison will be performing a necessary update of its utility billing platform July 20 - 21. During these two days, customers will not be able to make payments on their accounts, apply for service, or close their accounts online. Customers will not be able to access the customer self-service portal, and utility billing staff will not be able to access customer accounts during this time. New DART Bus Network Moved Stops from Addison Road to Quorum Drive



If you are wondering if there is more DART bus traffic on Quorum Drive lately, the answer is yes. In January 2022, DART adopted a new bus route system that impacted almost every route. DART's new plan was to refocus its buses around core high-frequency routes while making bus transportation more efficient and more effective. The new route map resulted in bus stops on Addison Road being shifted to Quorum Drive which has generated additional bus traffic along Quorum Drive.
