Construction Corner

DART Plans to Place Midway Road Bridge on August 29



DART's Silver Line design-build contractor Archer Western Herzog (AWH) placed the blue, decorative arches for the new bridge over Midway Road on Thursday, August 11. Another full Midway Road closure is tentatively scheduled for August 29 when AWH will place the actual bridge. More details will be posted on the [Town's website](#) when they are finalized.

Redding Trail Drainage and Amenity Improvements Substantially Complete



Town staff, design consultants, and contractor representatives met on Friday, August 12 to review the progress of the Redding Trail Project which includes replacing deteriorating wood retaining walls, addressing ADA issues, and improving drainage on Redding Trail North. They developed a punch list of items for the contractor to complete over the

next two weeks as weather permits. The project has been deemed to be substantially complete since the it functions according to its intended purpose.

The amenity portion of the project included significant improvements to two rest areas and six retaining walls along the trail. The previously existing railroad tie retaining walls were replaced with structural segmental walls. The pavers in the two seating areas were replaced with a full-color range of modular pavers in an attractive herringbone pattern. The benches for the two rest areas are expected to arrive the week of August 19 and will be installed immediately upon arrival. This portion of the project was paid for by bond funds approved by voters in 2019 as part of [Proposition C](#).

The drainage portion of the project included the development of 750 linear feet of concrete drainage swale east of Canot Lane in the Oncor easement. Additional tasks to be completed include grading adjustments near the channel, landscaping, and irrigation. This portion of the project was funded by the stormwater account.

The installation of all plant materials for the project was paused due to the drought and excessive heat we experienced this summer. This work is scheduled to resume after Labor Day.

Trinity Christian Academy Officially Opens New Middle School Building



Trinity Christian Academy (TCA) opened in Addison in 1976 and is one of only three schools located within Addison's borders. In the spring of 2021, the City Council approved TCA's request to build a new middle school building and library. On Tuesday, August 17, Mayor Joe Chow joined in the ribbon-cutting ceremony for the new addition and helped welcome students back to school.
