Construction Corner

Dallas Water Utilities Remobilizing at White Rock Creek



In February, Dallas Water Utilities (DWU) responded to a broken water line that runs along White Rock Creek. While DWU was able to complete leak repairs fairly quickly, site restoration has proven to be a complicated process. Their team has completed the engineering required for reconstructing the creek bank and will be mobilizing at the site again on October 3. This phase of the project entails the installation of 150 linear feet of gabion baskets like the ones pictured above along the White Rock Creek embankment and restoring the turf and trail damaged during the water line repair. The work is scheduled to be completed in February 2023.

During this construction period, portions of the street will be reduced to traffic for a short period of time to install the gabion walls. DWU has pledged to do everything possible to minimize the construction disruption to this area, but there may be some inconvenience as work progresses.

DWU is working closely with our Parks and Recreation and Public Works and Engineering Departments to ensure that the work adheres to Addison's high standards. Celestial Pump Station Landscaping Gets A Facelift





The Celestial Pump Station located at 5510 Celestial Rd was designed to resemble the local residential homes near Celestial Park. The building, constructed in the mid-1980s, was originally landscaped with traditional and formal plantings, which eventually became overgrown and outdated. In a joint venture between Addison's Public Works and Engineering and Parks and Recreation Departments, a landscape renovation project was set into motion with the development of a landscape plan in June of 2022. Landscape installation by Addison's Parks Operations team began in August and was completed on September 21. The project has made a positive impact on the neighborhood with many citizens stopping by to say thanks for a job well done.

Below is a list of recycling items that will be accepted:

- **Computers:** Desktops, laptops, servers, LCD monitors, keyboards, mice, speakers, and all other computer components.
- **Cameras:** Camcorders and all non-disposable film and digital cameras.
- **Office Equipment:** Fax machines, typewriters, inkjet cartridges, printers, scanners, routers, shredders, and copiers.
- **Entertainment Electronics:** Car and home audio equipment, satellite and cable boxes, VCRs, DVD players and recorders, headphones, and multimedia projectors.
- **Multimedia:** DVD and VHS movies, audiobooks, and music CDs. All multimedia items must include original covers.
- **Clothing & Accessories:** Pants, coats, shirts, purses, belts, shoes, hats, etc.
- **Toys & Games:** Action figures, blocks, dolls, stuffed animals, etc.
- **Portable Electronics:** Cell phones, GPS devices, calculators, CD, and DVD players, PDAs, and MP3 Players.
- **Video Games:** Video games, systems, and accessories.
- **Sporting Goods:** Golf clubs and bags, helmets, pads, baseball bats and gloves, basketball shoes, cleats, hockey sticks, skates, and roller blades.
- **Musical Instruments:** Guitars, percussion, strings, woodwinds, brass, and electric keyboards.
- **Home and Garden:** Air purifiers, baby monitors, vacuum cleaners, power tools, electric razors, sewing machines, & medical equipment.
- **Non-Fiction Books:** Cookbooks, craft books, textbooks, etc. Jewelry Gold, silver, watches, costume jewelry.
- **Food:** Non-perishable and canned food.
