

The New York-based business was selected to redevelop a 6-acre site located on Chennault Drive. They plan to construct a total of six private jet hangars totaling 101,000 square feet dedicated to serving high-end business aviation users including corporate and private flight departments. The estimated construction value of the building improvements exceeds \$15 million.
