

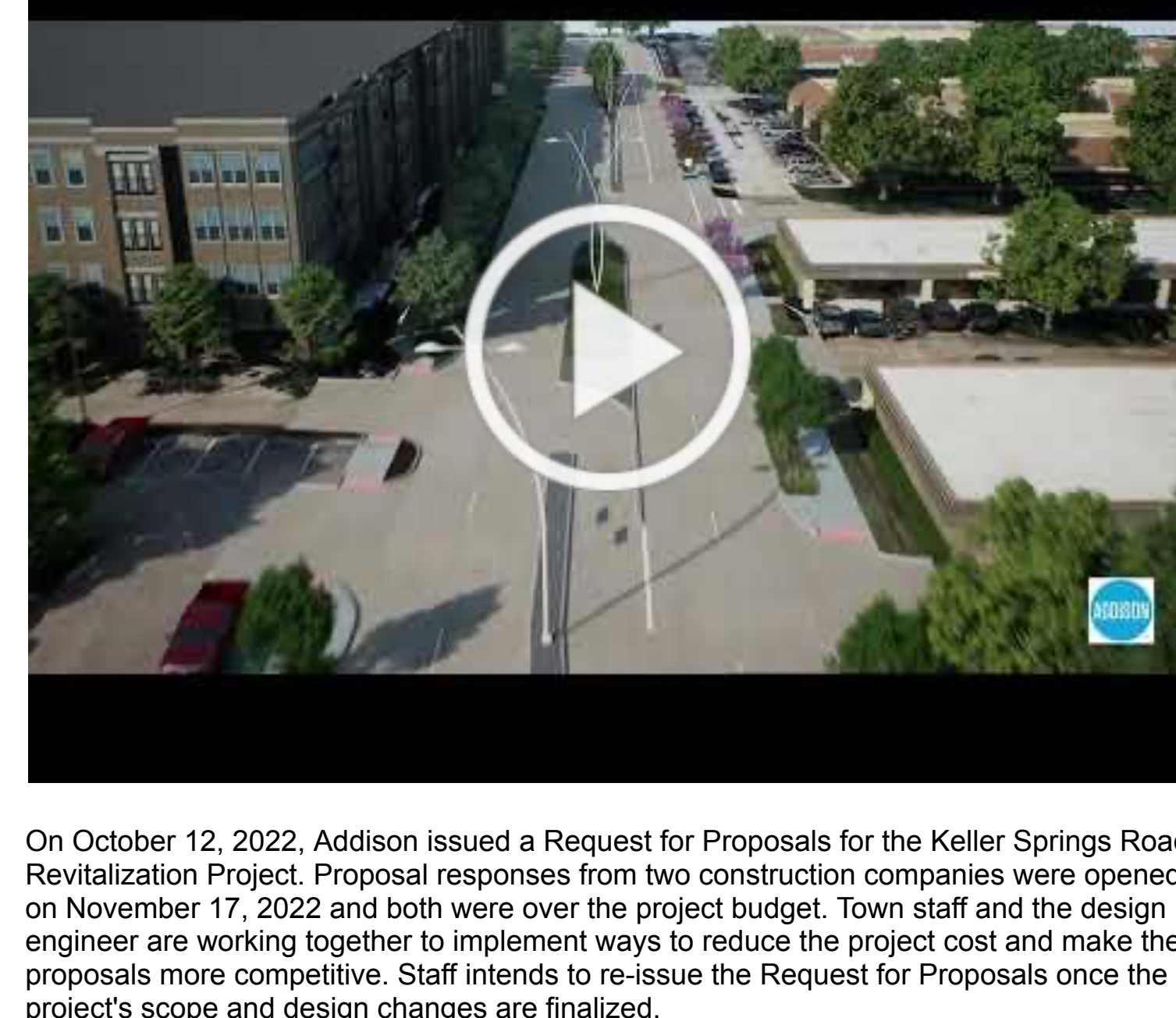

**Keller Springs Road Revitalization Project Update**



On October 12, 2022, Addison issued a Request for Proposals for the Keller Springs Road Revitalization Project. Proposal responses from two construction companies were opened on November 17, 2022 and both were over the project budget. Town staff and the design engineer are working together to implement ways to reduce the project cost and make the proposals more competitive. Staff intends to re-issue the Request for Proposals once the project's scope and design changes are finalized.

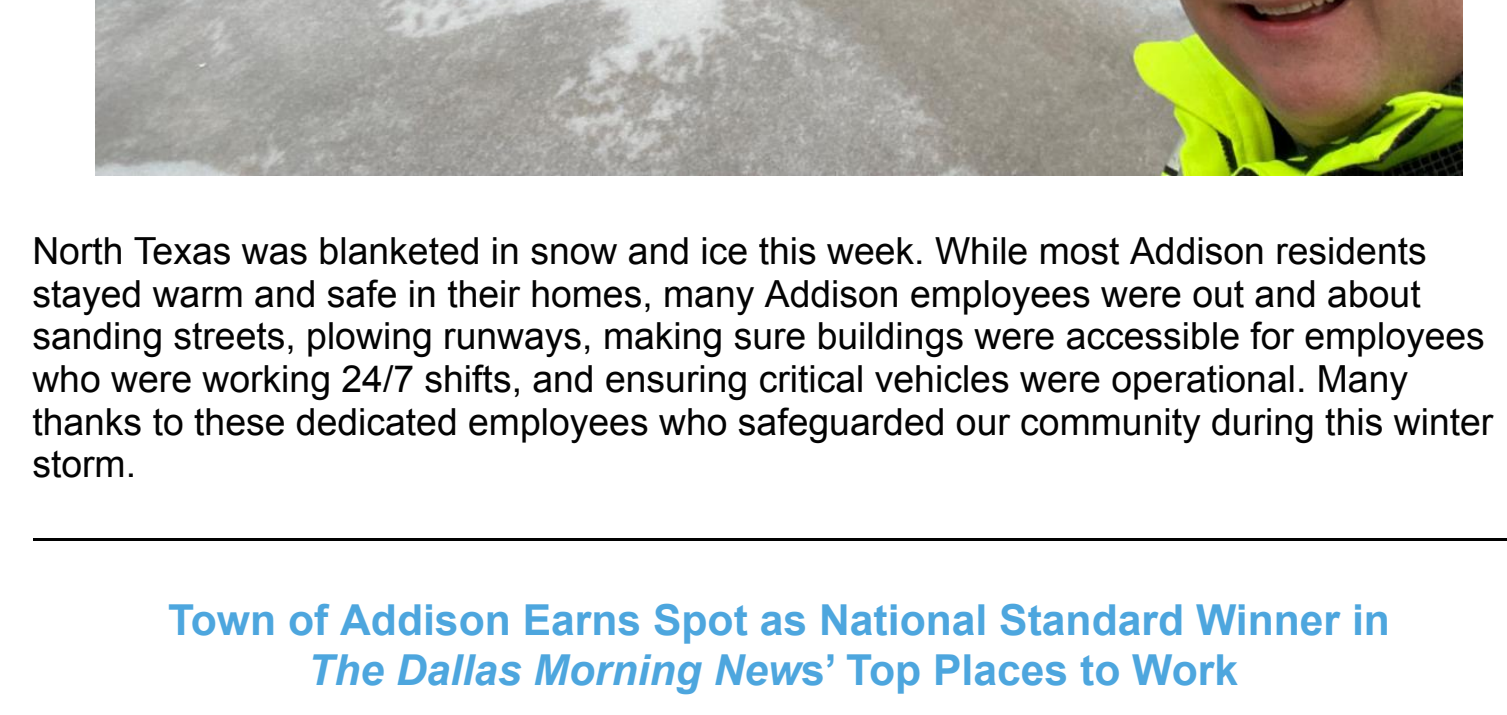

**Town of Addison Earns Spot as National Standard Winner in 'The Dallas Morning News' Top Places to Work**

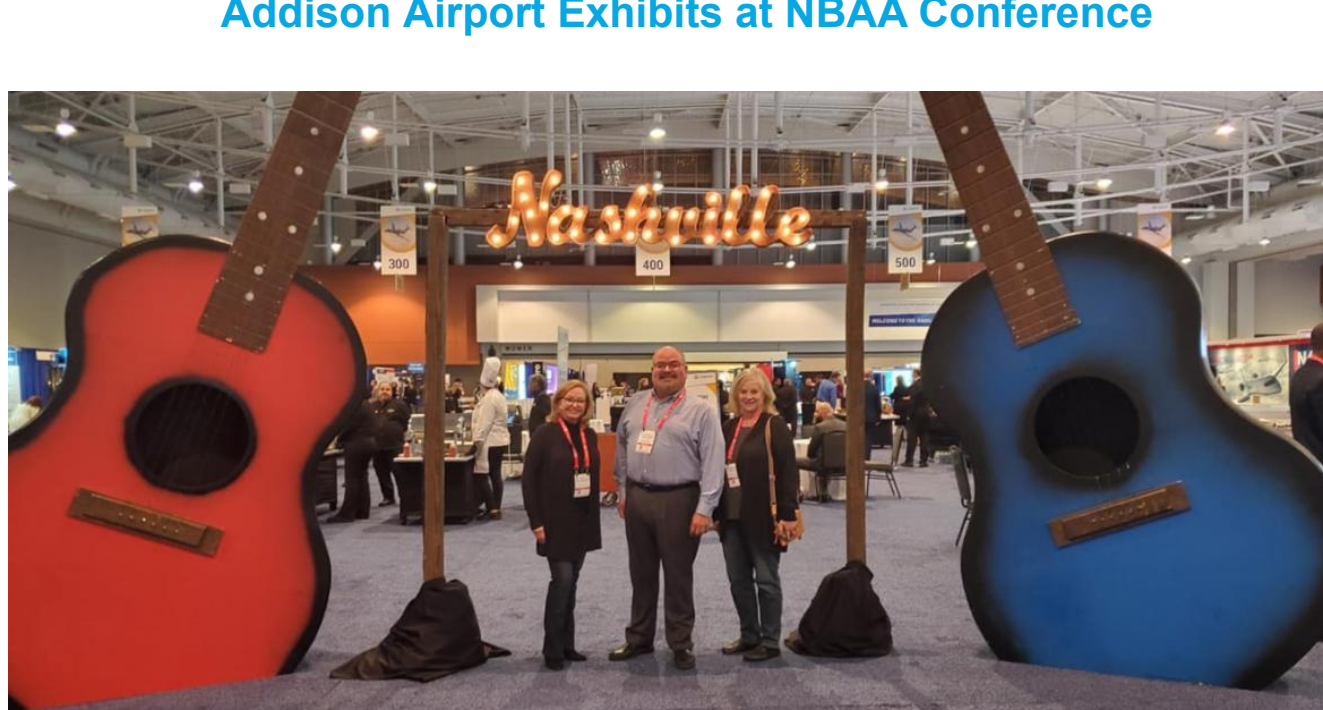
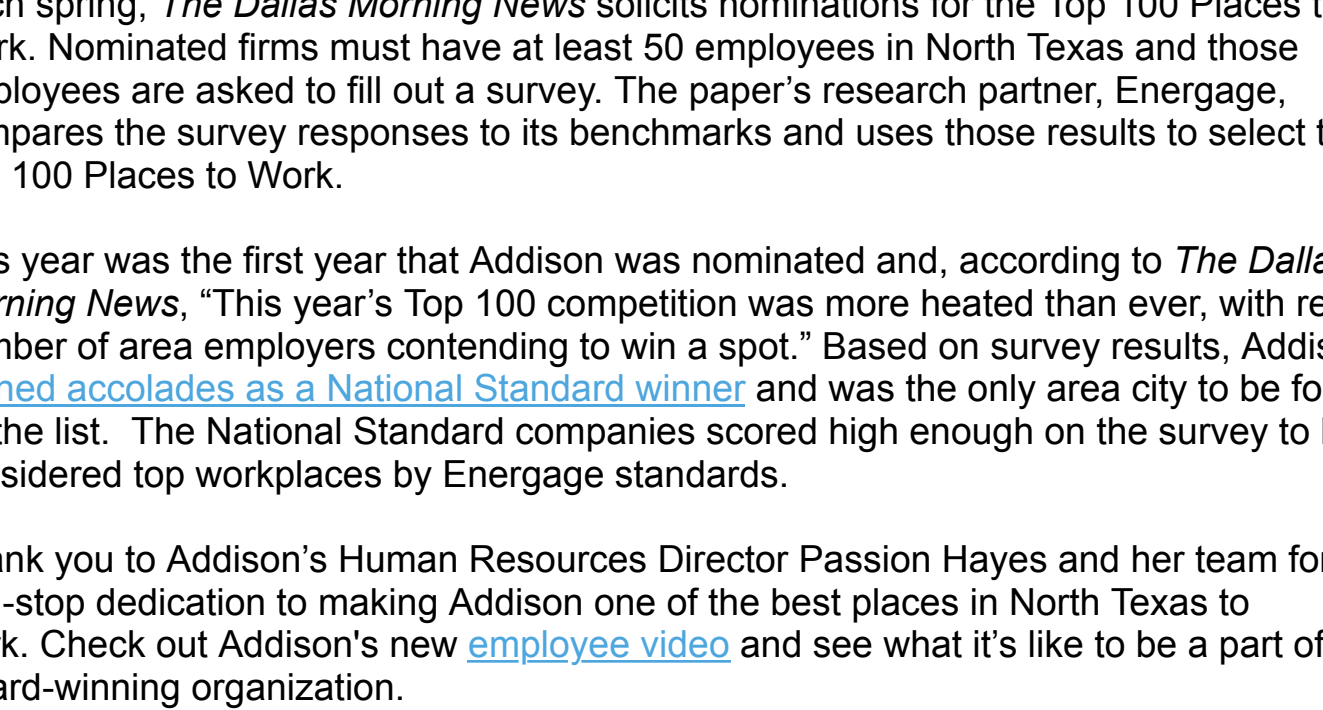


Each spring, *The Dallas Morning News* solicits nominations for the Top 100 Places to Work. Nominated firms must have at least 50 employees in North Texas and those employees are asked to fill out a survey. The paper's research partner, Energage, compares the survey responses to its benchmarks and uses those results to select the Top 100 Places to Work.

This year was the first year that Addison was nominated and, according to *The Dallas Morning News*, "This year's Top 100 competition was more heated than ever, with record numbers of area employees contending to win a spot." Based on survey results, Addison [earned accolades as a National Standard winner](#) and was the only area city to be found on the list. The National Standard companies scored high enough on the survey to be considered top workplaces by Energage standards.

**Addison Airport Exhibits at NBAA Conference**

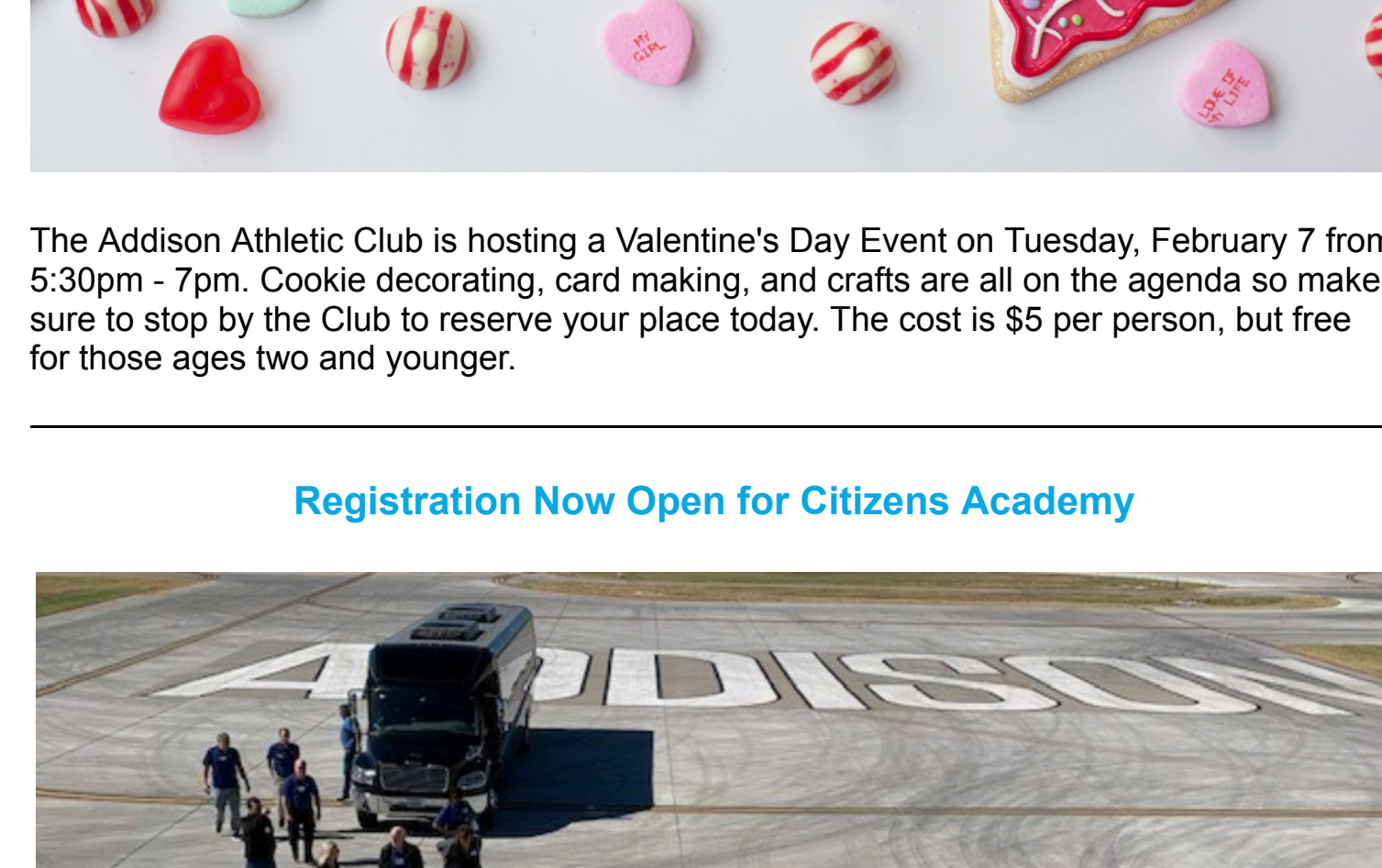

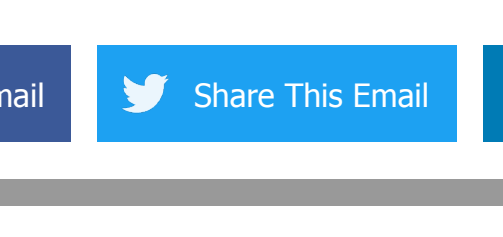
