

Council Updates



Unofficial election results indicate that Bruce Arfsten will be Addison's next Mayor and Nancy Craig, Dan Liscio, and Marlin Willesen will be the Town's new Council Members. Election results will be canvassed at a special meeting on May 17. The May 17 meeting is scheduled to begin at 6pm and will be held at Addison Town Hall, 5300 Belt Line Road.
