Saturday, May 6 is Election Day



Saturday, May 6 is Election Day and Addison residents can vote at any Dallas County Vote Center from 7am - 7pm. There will be two Vote Centers located in Addison:

- Loos Field House - 3815 Spring Valley Road
- Addison Conference Centre - 15650 Addison Road

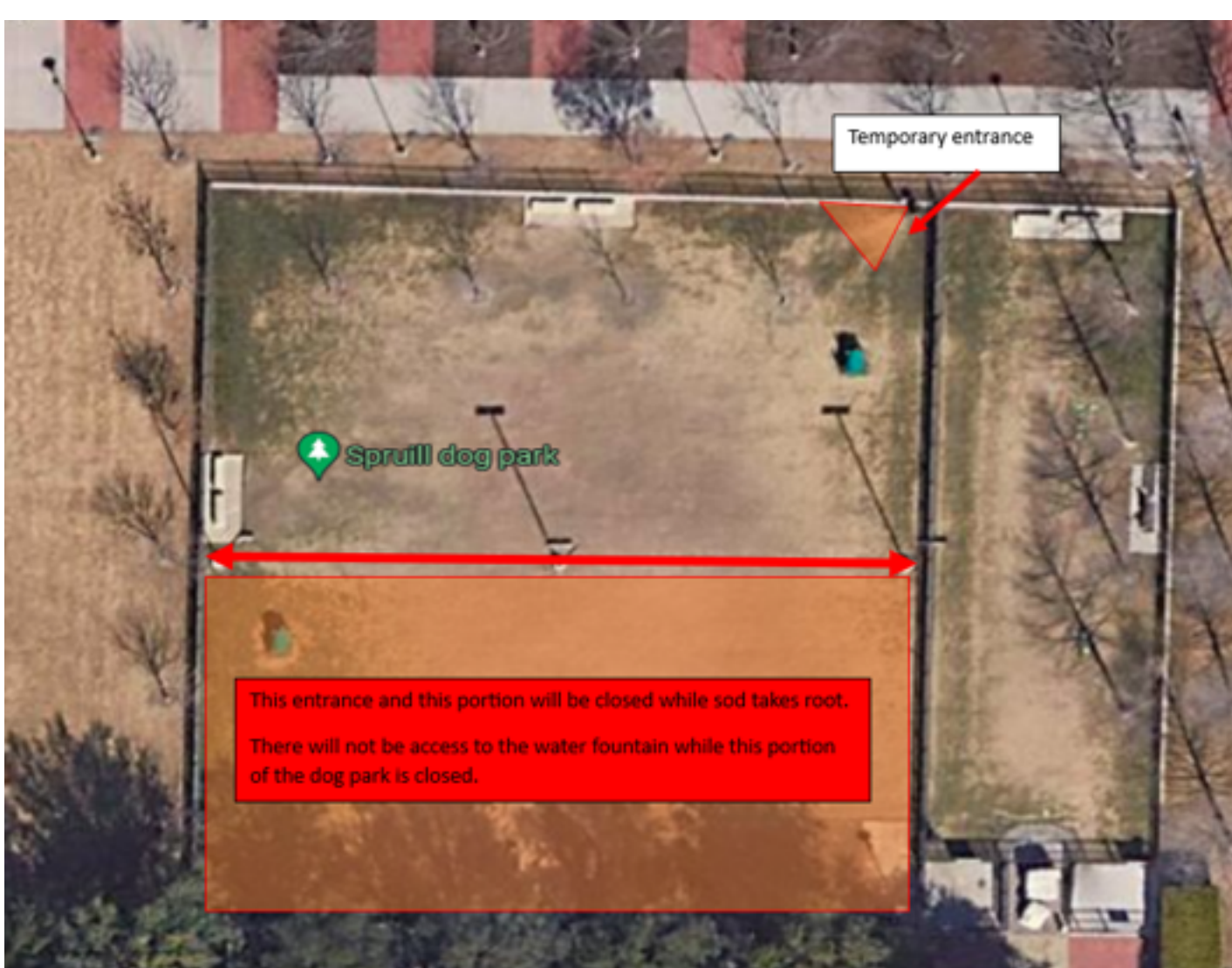
May 9 City Council Meeting Postponed to May 17

According to Addison's Charter, "returns of all municipal elections shall be made by the election officers to the Council at the first City Council meeting following the election, which shall be the meeting to canvass the election and declare the results in accordance with state law." Since it typically takes Dallas County 10 days to deliver the canvassing results of an election, Council has postponed its May 9 meeting until May 17. This date is subject to change if results are not received before the May 17 meeting. Addison posts agendas [on the Town's website](#) three days prior to a meeting.

The May 17 meeting is scheduled to begin at 6pm and will be held at Addison Town Hall, 5300 Belt Line Road.

Turf Replacement Project for the Big Dog Side of Spruill Dog Park to Begin May 8



The volume of dogs that enjoy the big dog section of Spruill Dog Park has worn out the grass, so the Parks and Recreation Department will be starting a turf replacement project on May 8. The first phase of the project is to re-sod the southern half of the big dog side of the park. From May 8 through May 30, the main gate to the big dog side of the park will be closed. There will be a temporary entrance available on the north side of the park so residents can still access the northern half of the big dog park (see map above). Since the water fountains are located in the area being re-sodded first, there will not be water available during this three-week window.

Weather permitting, work will switch to the northern half of the big dog section the week of June 12 and will take approximately three weeks to complete. When phase two begins, the main gate will be reopened and the water fountains will be available.

The small dog section of the dog park will not be impacted by this project and will remain open.

We appreciate your patience as we work to maintain this beloved community amenity.

Addison TreeHouse Officially Closed

The Addison TreeHouse in Office on the Park has officially closed. In August 2022, the City Council approved a [\\$170 million multi-use development](#) for the complex and the developers have recently begun demolition to kick off the project. Addison's Economic Development Department has relocated to the Addison Conference Centre and the Public Works & Engineering Bonds team has moved to new office space off of Keller Springs Road.

City Council and Planning and Zoning Commission meetings will move to the Conference Centre. If you plan to attend an upcoming meeting, please make sure to confirm the location on the [Council agenda](#), which is posted on the Town's website three days prior to a meeting.
