**Council Updates Addison Council Approves Fourth Amendment to Addison Circle Transit-**

## **Oriented Development Plan**



original MOU was approved on April 12, 2022. Subsequent amendments were made on November 8, 2022, January 10, 2023, and April 25, 2023, which updated the project schedule, made minor modifications to square footage and residential units, and adjusted economic development incentives for Stream and AMLI. The fourth approved amendment encompasses modifications to the development plan, including revised building heights and parking configurations, and updates to economic development incentives. These changes, which will require amending the project zoning, are designed to optimize the project's design, functionality, and economic viability,






