

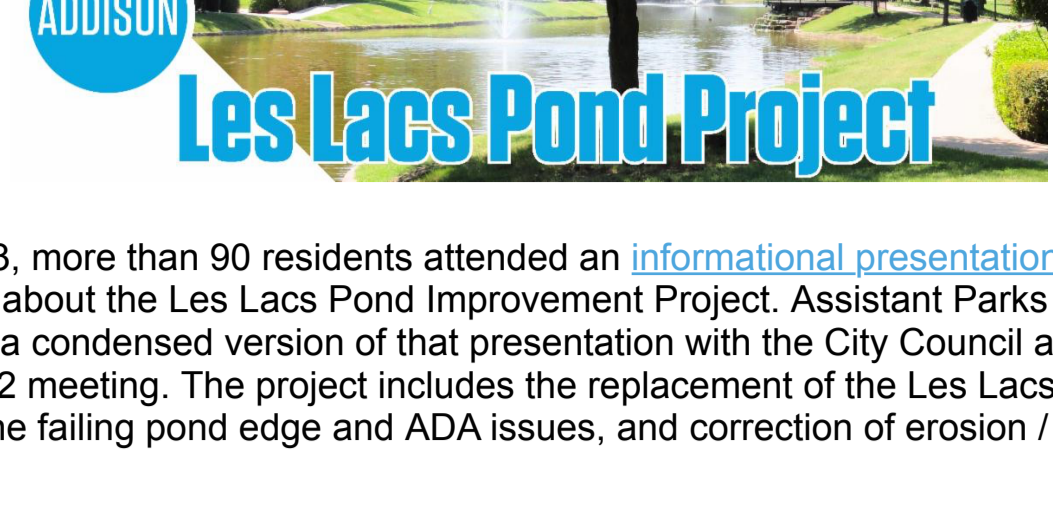

Council Updates

Council Receives Les Lacs Improvement Project Update



On August 23, more than 90 residents attended an informational presentation at the Athletic Club about the Les Lacs Pond Improvement Project. Assistant Parks Director Joe Paik shared a condensed version of that presentation with the City Council at its September 12 meeting. The project includes the replacement of the Les Lacs Pond liner, addressing the falling pond edge and ADA issues, and correction of erosion / maintenance concerns.

The Addison City Council will convene for the work session in the Acacia Room beginning at 6:00 PM.

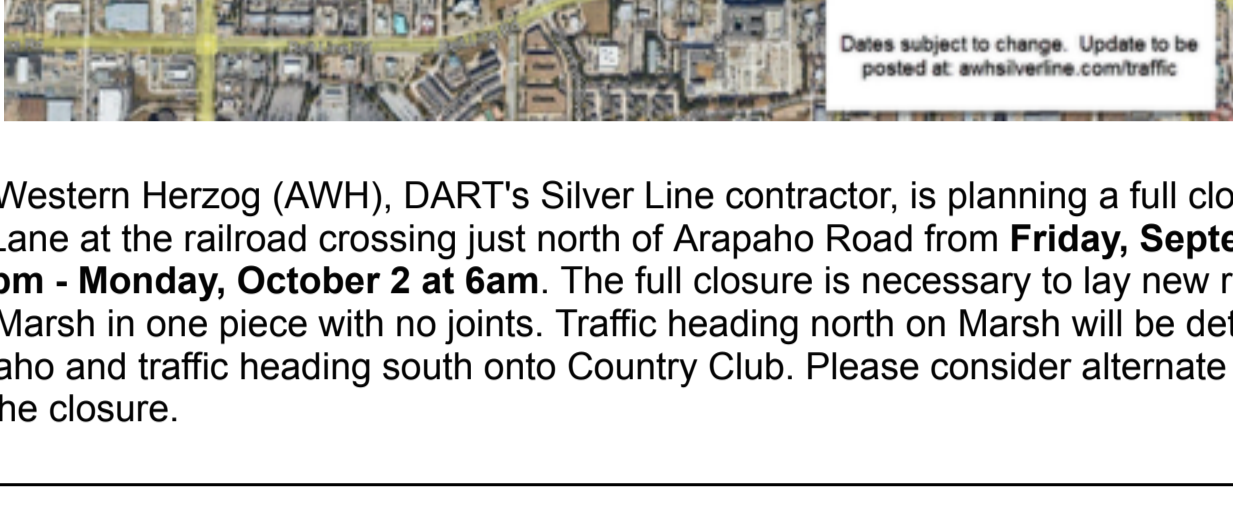
- Call Meeting to Order and Announce that a Quorum is Present.

City Council meeting agendas are posted on the Town's website and shared with Council Members three days prior to any meeting. After reviewing it, the Council will send questions about specific items to the city management team. Town staff will provide responses before the meeting. In order to provide valuable insights into the Council's decision-making process and promote a more inclusive local governance experience, this question-and-answer document is now included as a dedicated agenda item.

Construction News

Three-Day Marsh Lane Closure Scheduled for 9/29 - 10/2



Archer Western Herzog (AWH), DART's Silver Line contractor, is planning a full closure of Marsh Lane at the railroad crossing just north of Arapaho Road from Friday, September 29 at 8pm - Monday, October 2 at 6am. The full closure is necessary to lay new rail across Marsh in one piece with no joints. Traffic heading north on Marsh will be detoured to Arapaho and traffic heading south onto County Club. Please consider alternate routes during the closure.

Stormwater Detention System Placement Complete



This week, the contractor for the [Barnette Creek Basin Drainage and ADA Improvements Project](#) placed the stormwater detention drainage structure at the end of the trail along Marsh Lane. This system, which is the first of its kind in the area, will help the Town manage the runoff from the upgraded stormwater system recently installed in the adjacent neighborhood. Over the next month, new sod will be installed in the impacted area and landscaping will be replaced before the trail is reopened in mid to late October.

Thank you to residents for their patience as we work to make Addison a better place to live, work, and play.

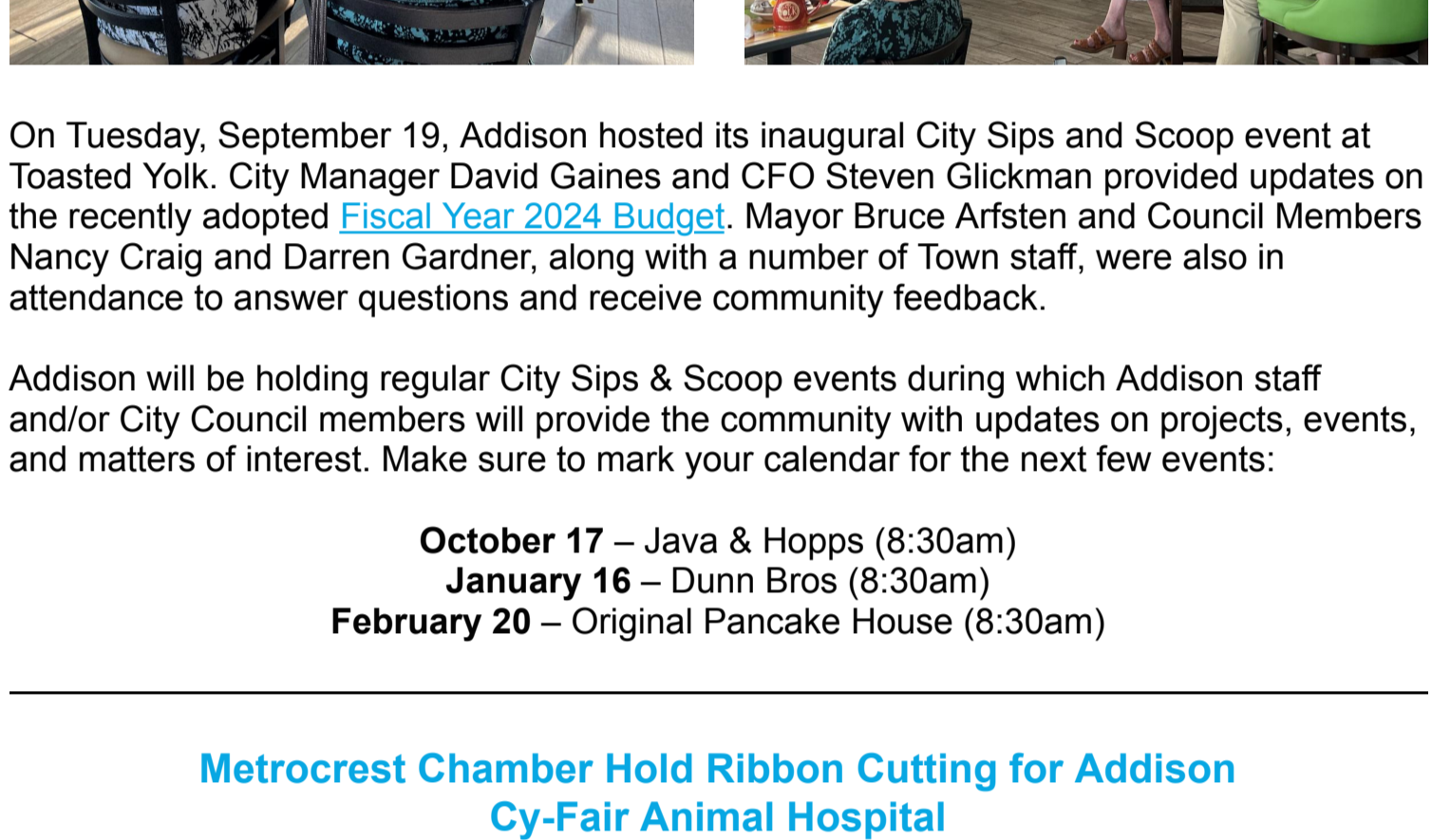

Addison Hosts Inaugural City Sips and Scoop

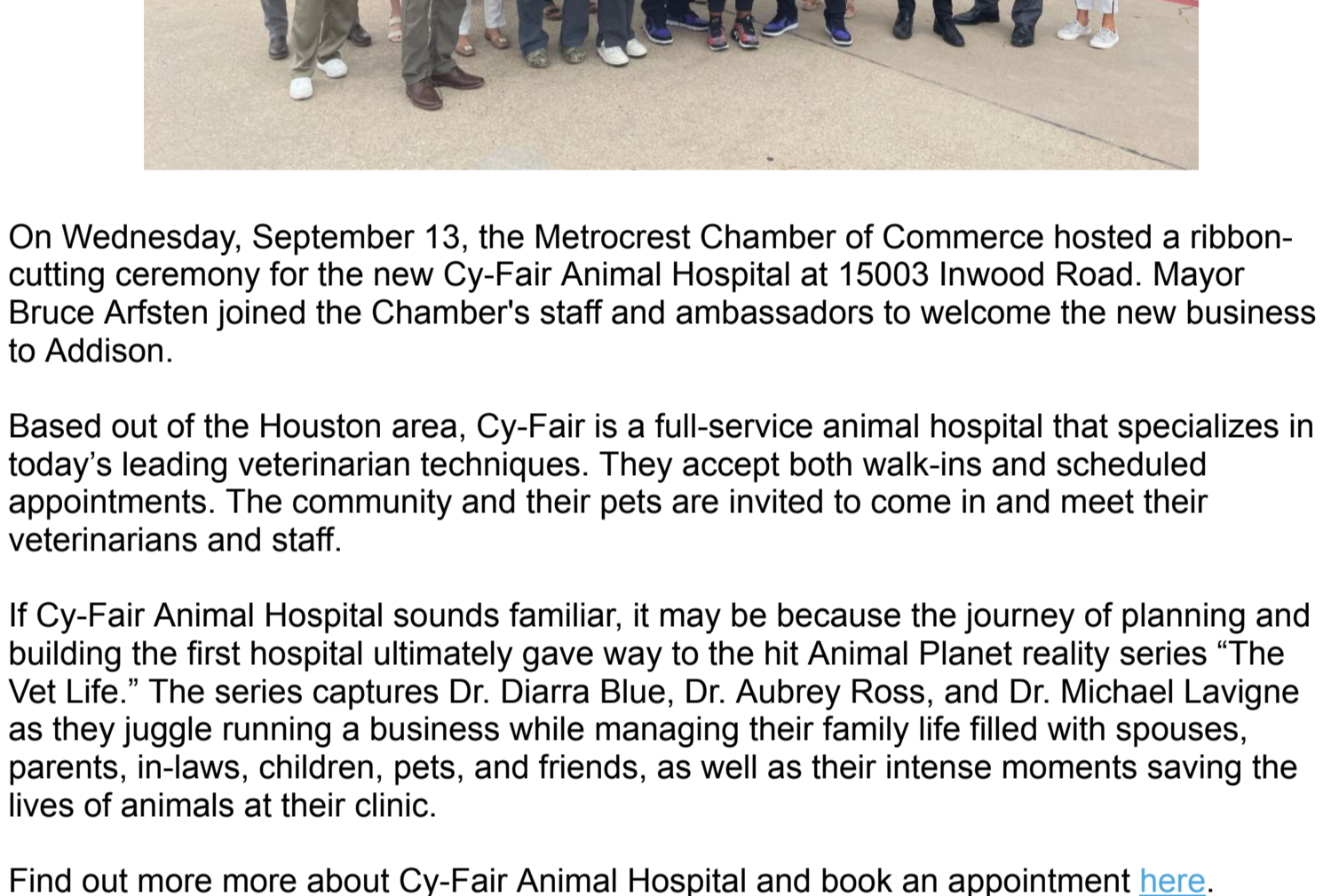

Metrocrest Chamber Hold Ribbon Cutting for Addison Cy-Fair Animal Hospital



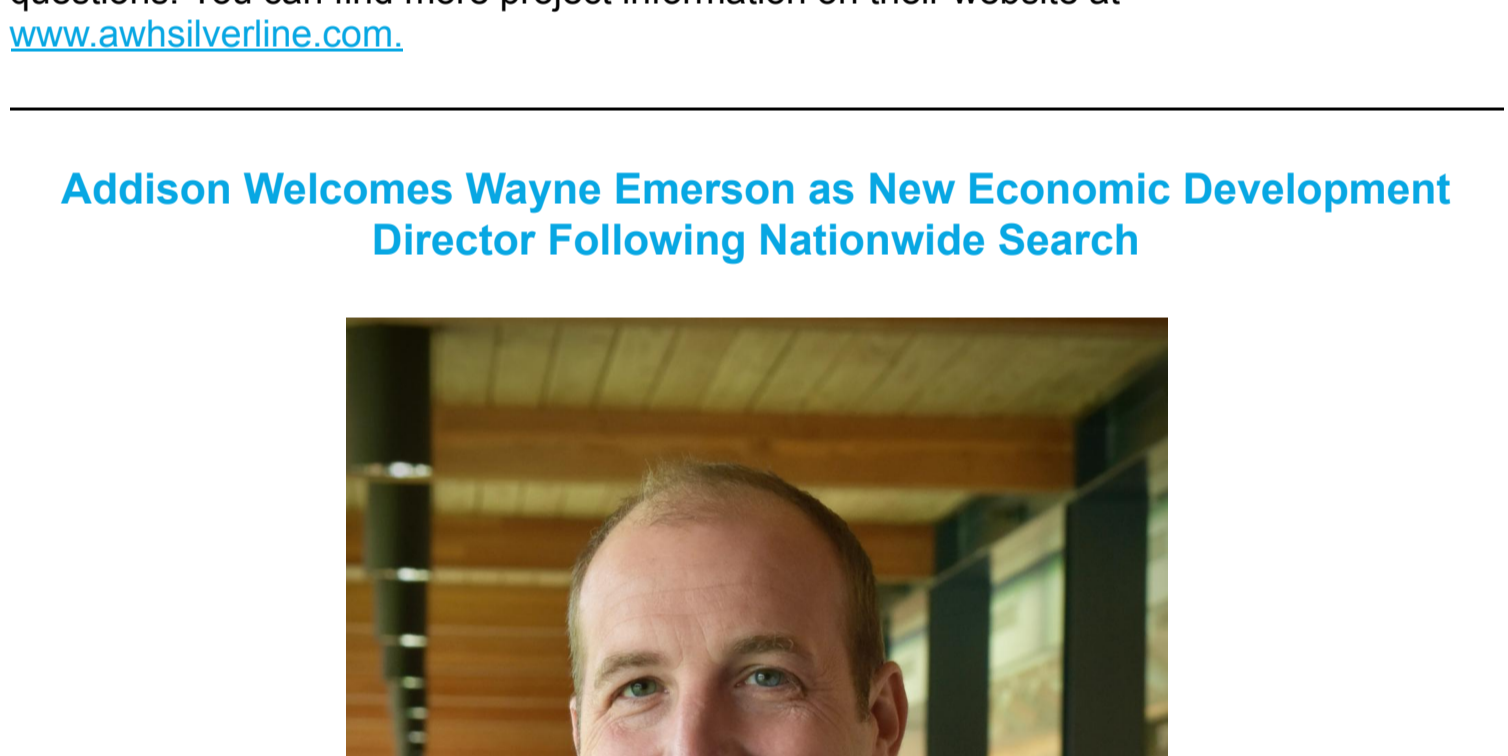

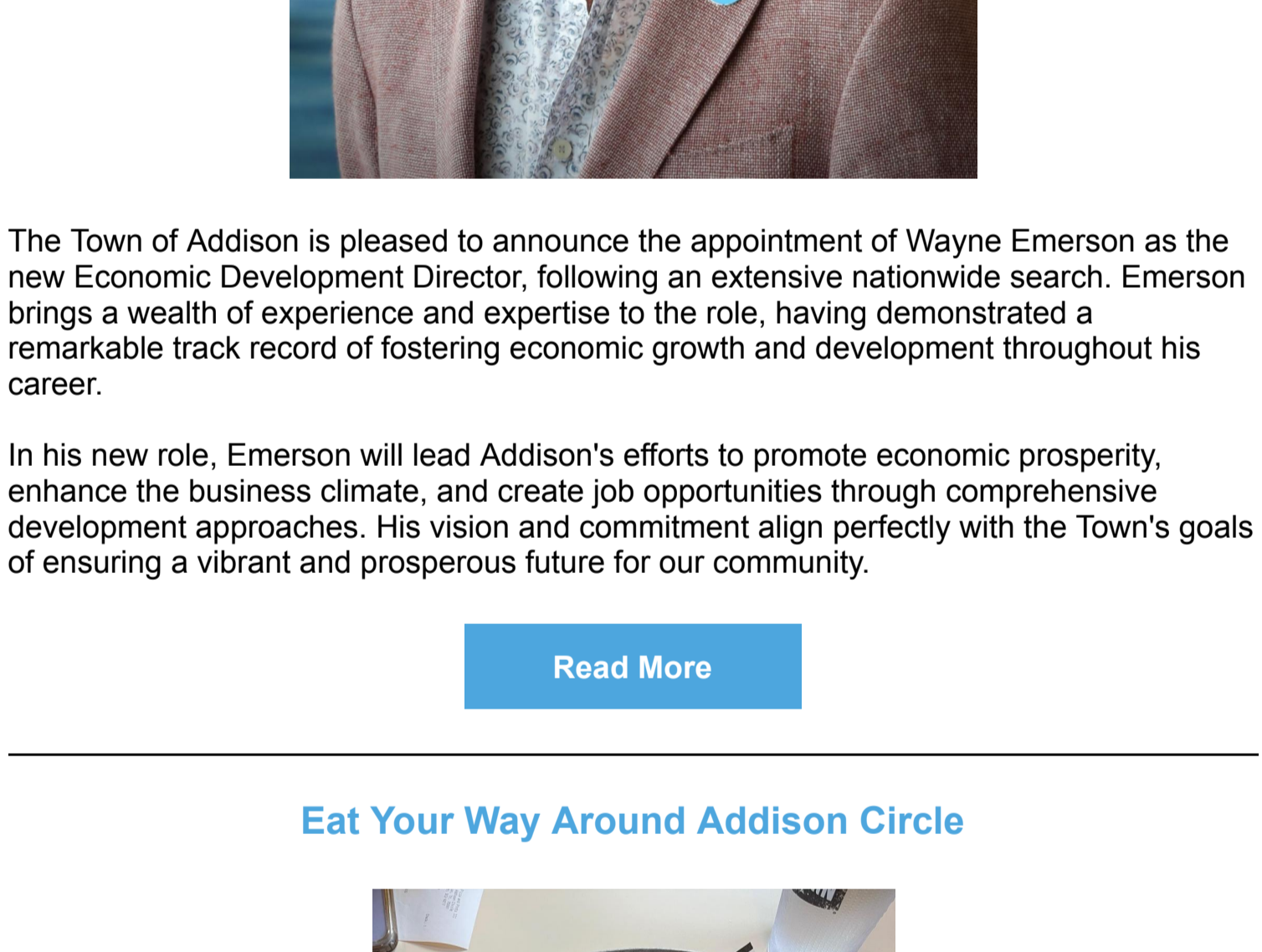

Addison Welcomes Wayne Emerson as New Economic Development Director Following Nationwide Search

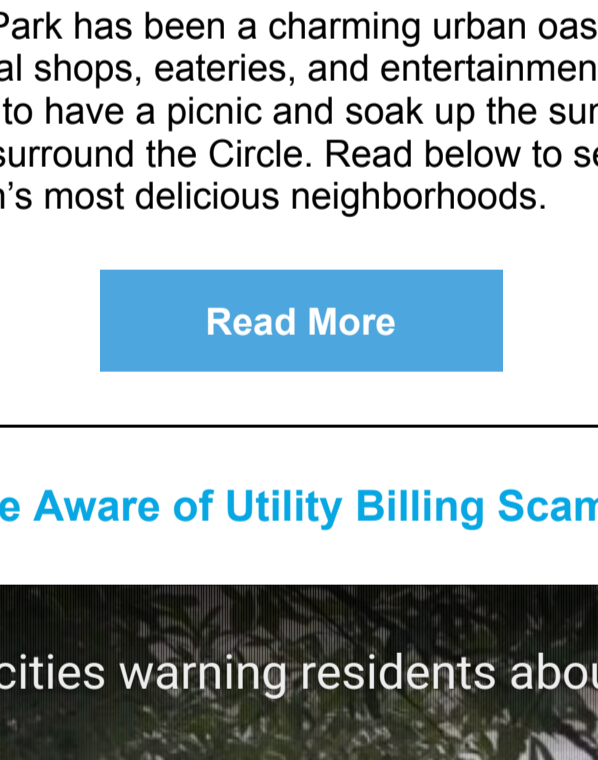

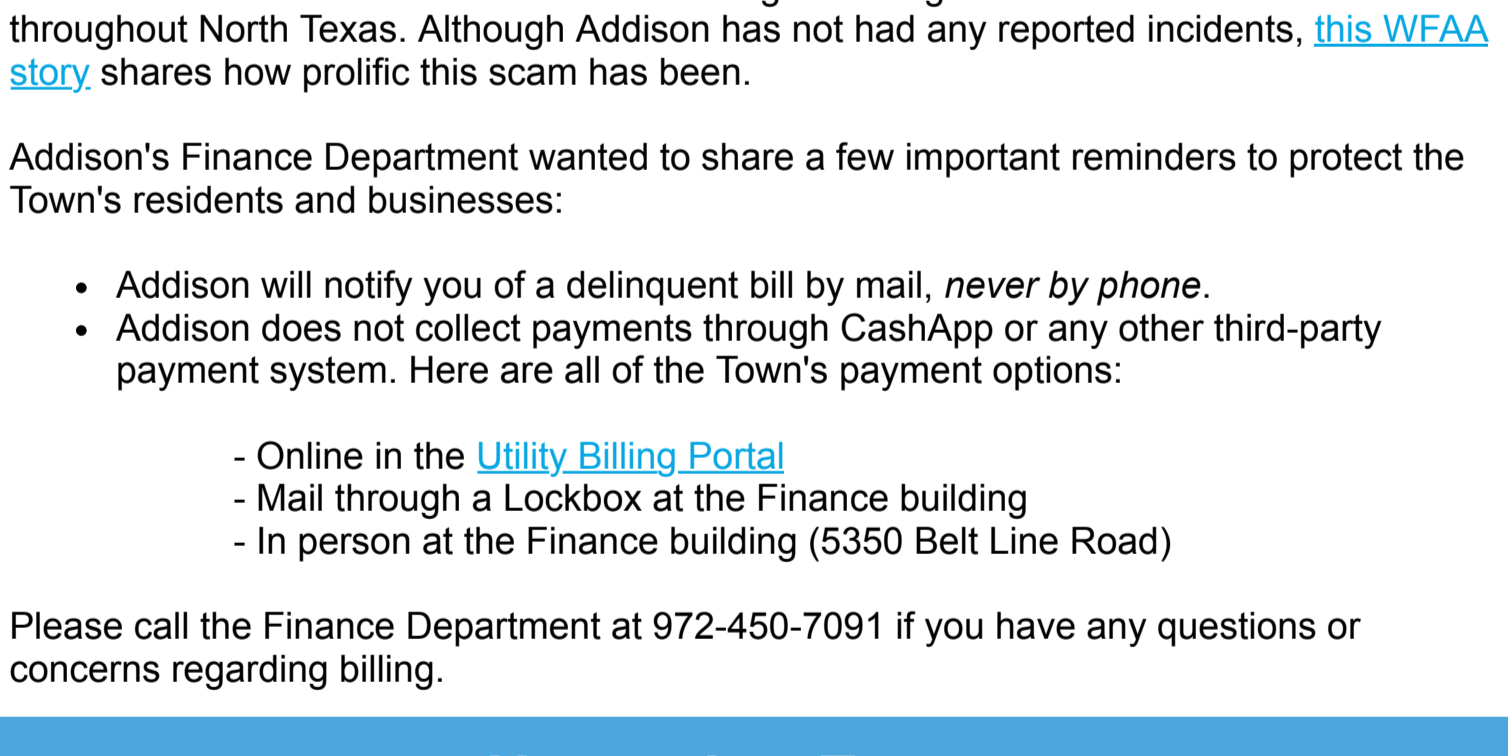
Eat Your Way Around Addison Circle
